

RESOLUTION NO. R-2013-107

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PURCHASE ORDER BETWEEN THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI AND 2ND CHANCE HOLDINGS, INC., D/B/A BUDGET CAR RENTAL, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SOUTHEAST FLORIDA GOVERNMENTAL PURCHASING COOPERATIVE GROUP - RFP NUMBER 13-C-103, TO PROVIDE THE POLICE DEPARTMENT WITH UNDERCOVER VEHICLE RENTAL SERVICES, IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$105,000.00) PER YEAR; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2013, the City of Coral Springs, Florida, ("Coral Springs") issued *RFP No. 13-C-103RFP - Undercover Vehicle Rental Services* ("RFP"), on behalf of the Southeast Florida Governmental Purchasing Cooperative ("Purchasing Co-op"), requesting competitive sealed proposals from qualified contractors to furnish police undercover vehicle leasing services for all government entities participating in the Purchasing Co-op, in accordance with the terms, conditions, requirements and specifications contained in the RFP ("Services"); and

WHEREAS, in response to the RFP, 2nd Chance Holdings, Inc., d/b/a Budget Car Rental ("Contractor") submitted its proposal and was competitively selected by Coral Springs as having established the terms and conditions required in the RFP; and

WHEREAS, on July 8, 2013, Coral Springs entered into an agreement with Contractor, for the provision of Services commencing September 1, 2013, through August 31, 2015, with the option to renew for two (2) additional, two (2) year terms ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, on October 23, 2007, the Mayor and Council of the City of North Miami ("City"), adopted Ordinance 1244 authorizing the City Manager to approve the purchase of supplies, goods and/or services from current contracts of other governmental entities, including the Purchasing Co-op; and

WHEREAS, the City is a participating member of the Purchasing Co-op, hence the Contractor is willing to provide Services to the City with the same favorable rates and price structure made available to Coral Springs under the Agreement; and


WHEREAS, the City Manager has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to piggyback the Agreement for the provision of Services, at a cost not to exceed One Hundred Five Thousand Dollars (\$105,000.00) per year.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:


Section 1. Authority of City Manager. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the City Manager to execute a Purchase Order between the City of North Miami and 2nd Chance Holdings, Inc., d/b/a Budget Car Rental, in accordance with the Southeast Florida Governmental Purchasing Cooperative Group - RFP Number 13-C-103, to provide the Police Department with Undercover Vehicle Rental Services, in the amount not to exceed One Hundred Five Thousand Dollars (\$105,000.00) per year.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


