

RESOLUTION NO. R-2013-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ISSUE A PURCHASE ORDER IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-FOUR THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE DOLLARS AND TWENTY-FIVE CENTS (\$134,445.25), TO PIGGYBACK A CONTRACT AWARD WITH THE CITY OF MIAMI, FLORIDA, FOR THE PURCHASE OF EMERGENCY POLICE VEHICLE EQUIPMENT FROM SIGNAL TECHNOLOGY ENTERPRISES, INC., IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CITY OF MIAMI INVITATION FOR BID NUMBER 270252; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on November 7, 2011, the City of Miami, Florida (the "City of Miami"), issued *Invitation for Bid 270252 – Purchase and/or Installation of Additional Emergency Vehicle Equipment* ("IFB"), seeking qualified bidders to furnish, deliver and/or install additional emergency vehicle equipment in accordance with the technical specifications, terms and conditions contained in the IFB ("Services"); and

WHEREAS, in response to the IFB, Signal Technology Enterprises, Inc. ("Contractor"), was competitively selected and awarded a contract for the period of February 2, 2012 through February 1, 2014, pursuant to City of Miami Resolution R-12-0033; and

WHEREAS, on October 23, 2007, the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami ("City"), adopted Ordinance No. 1244, authorizing the City Manager to approve the purchase of supplies, goods and/or services from current contracts of other municipalities and governmental entities ("piggyback"), such as the City of Miami; and

WHEREAS, the City administration has identified the need for Services as an essential element in protecting the public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, Contractor is willing to provide Services to the City at the same favorable rates and terms extended to the City of Miami; and


WHEREAS, the City administration respectfully requests that the Mayor and City Council approve the purchase of Services, piggybacking the City of Miami contract award, in order to obtain Services diligently and under the most cost effective means available to the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Authority of City Manager. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the City Manager to issue a purchase order in the amount not to exceed One Hundred Thirty-Four Thousand Four Hundred Forty-Five Dollars and Twenty-Five cents (\$134,445.25), to piggyback a contract award with the City of Miami, Florida, for the purchase of emergency police vehicle equipment from Signal Technology Enterprises, Inc., in accordance with the City of Miami Invitation for Bid Number 270252.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


