

RESOLUTION NO. R-2013-70

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ISSUE PURCHASE ORDERS TO FOUR (4) PRE-QUALIFIED VENDORS FOR THE PURCHASE AND REPAIRS OF PUMPS, DRIVES AND MOTORS, ON AN AS NEEDED WHEN NEEDED BASIS, IN ACCORDANCE WITH MIAMI-DADE COUNTY INVITATION TO BID NUMBER 6819-5/17 PUMPS, DRIVES, AND MOTORS: PURCHASE OF NEW AND REBUILT UNITS AND PARTS, AND REPAIR SERVICES, AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$200,000.00), FOR THE TERM COMMENCING MAY 1, 2013 THROUGH APRIL 30, 2014; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Miami-Dade County (“County”) Department of Procurement Management, Purchasing Division issued *Invitation for Bid Number 6819-5/17 Pumps, Drives, and Motors: Purchase of New and Rebuilt Units and Parts, and Repair and Maintenance Services* (“IFB”), to prequalify bidders meeting or exceeding minimum procurement requirements, to be accessed by various County departments for the purchase and repairs of pumps, drives, and motors (units and parts), on an as needed, when needed basis (“Services”); and

WHEREAS, in response to the IFB, the County ranked and prequalified the following four (4) companies for the provision of Services, in accordance with the terms, conditions and specifications contained in the IFB: 1) Florida Bearings, 2) Doneright Pumps Inc., 3) Barney’s Pumps, Inc., and 4) TAC Armatures & Pumps Corp. (collectively referred to as, “Approved Vendors”); and

WHEREAS, the County’s term of contract for the provision of Services by the Approved Vendors, commenced on May 1, 2013 through April 30, 2014, with the availability of a one (1) year option to renew; and

WHEREAS, a review of the IFB reveals the potential for the City to obtain Services on an as needed when needed basis from Approved Vendors offering a reliable source of Services at the lowest available price; and

WHEREAS, on October 23, 2007, the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami ("City"), adopted Ordinance 1244, which authorizes the City Manager to approve the purchase of supplies, goods and/or services from current contracts and awards of other governmental entities ("piggyback"), such as the County; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has determined that it is in the City's best interest to piggyback the County's award under the IFB in order to obtain reliable Services while utilizing the most cost effective means currently available to the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Authority of City Manager. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the City Manager to issue purchase orders to four (4) pre-qualified vendors for the purchase and repairs of pumps, drives and motors, on an as needed when needed basis, in accordance with Miami-Dade County Invitation to Bid Number 6819-5/17 Pumps, Drives, and Motors: Purchase of New and Rebuilt Units and Parts, and Repair Services, at a cost not to exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00), for the term commencing May 1, 2013 through April 30, 2014.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


