

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-R-137

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER TO ISSUE PURCHASE ORDERS ON AN AS-NEEDED BASIS, FOR THE PURCHASE OF TIRES AND RELATED SERVICES FOR CITY FLEET VEHICLES, IN THE AGGREGATE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000.00) PER YEAR FROM TWO (2) COMPETITIVELY SELECTED VENDORS (MIAMI TIRESOLES, INC., AND GOODYEAR AUTO SERVICE CENTER), TO PIGGYBACK THE COMPETITIVE AWARDS ISSUED BY THE FLORIDA SHERIFFS ASSOCIATION UNDER THE INVITATION TO BID TIRES AND RELATED SERVICES BID NUMBER 15/17-07-0220; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, on January 14, 2015 and January 21, 2015, the Florida Sheriffs Association (“Association”) advertised *Invitation to Bid Tires and Related Services Bid Number 15/17-07-0220* (“IFB”) on behalf of participating sheriffs’ offices and local government agencies of the State of Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, as a result of the IFB, a number of companies responded and were competitively selected (“Award”) for the provision of tires and related services, including mounting, installation of new valve stems, balancing, and disposal of used tires (collectively referred to herein as “Services”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Award is designed to provide participating agencies and local municipal governments with a mechanism for increasing their purchasing power by offering the most economically priced Services, tailored to the agency’s specific needs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Association guarantees participating agencies and local municipal governments, the availability of competitive pricing under the Award from Miami Tiresoles, Inc., and Goodyear Auto Service Center as selected vendors (“Vendors”), for the period commencing on the effective date of the Award through February 28, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, City administration has identified the need for Services to properly maintain the City’s vehicle fleet and for continued operational use in a safe manner; and

**WHEREAS**, Services will not exceed the aggregate amount of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) per year, from the two (2) Vendors; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 23, 2007, the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, adopted Ordinance 1244, which authorizes the City Manager to approve the purchase of supplies, goods and/or services from current contracts of other governmental entities (“piggyback”), such as the Florida Sheriffs Association; and


**WHEREAS**, the Interim City Manager has determined that it is in the City’s best interest to piggyback the Award in order to expeditiously purchase Services for immediate use, while utilizing the most cost-effective means currently available to the City.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1.** **Authority of Interim City Manager.** The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the Interim City Manager to issue Purchase Orders on an as-needed basis, for the purchase of tires and related services for City fleet vehicles, in the aggregate amount not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) per year from two (2) competitively selected vendors (Miami Tiresoles, Inc., and Goodyear Auto Service Center), to piggyback the competitive awards issued by the Florida Sheriffs Association under the *Invitation to Bid Tires and Related Services Bid Number 15/17-07-0220*.

**Section 2.** **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
