

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-R-41

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ALLOCATION OF SEVEN HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$700,000.00) TOWARDS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS, ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS, STREET LIGHTING, LANDSCAPING, HOME IMPROVEMENTS AND HOME BEAUTIFICATION PROJECTS CITY WIDE, AS FOLLOWS: ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000.00) FOR DISTRICT 1, ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000.00) FOR DISTRICT 2, ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000.00) FOR DISTRICT 4, AND THE REMAINING FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$400,000.00) TO BE ALLOCATED FOR THE MAYOR TO IMPLEMENT CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND OTHER PROJECTS, AS DETERMINED BY THE CITY MANAGER; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, City of North Miami ("City") is desirous of improving the City's capital assets and infrastructure, and to enhance resident's quality of life by investing funds towards roadway improvements, street lighting, landscaping, home improvements and home beautification projects City wide ("Improvements"); and

WHEREAS, the proposed Improvements will increase the value of capital assets and extend their useful life, ensure that levels of services are maintained if not improved, and aesthetically increase the City's appearance to residents and visitors alike; and

WHEREAS, City administration respectfully requests the allocation of Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$700,000.00) to implement the Improvements, as follows: One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) for District 1, One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) for District 2, One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) for District 4, and the remaining Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00) to be allocated for the Mayor to implement Capital Improvements and other projects, as determined by the City Manager; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council find the allocation of funds to support and accomplish the Improvements, constitutes a decisive investment for the City and promotes the public health, safety, and welfare.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA THAT:

Section 1. Allocation of funds for Capital Improvements and other Projects. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby approve the allocation of Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$700,000.00) towards capital improvements, roadway improvements, street lighting, landscaping, home improvements and home beautification projects City wide, as follows: One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) for District 1, One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) for District 2, One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) for District 4, and the remaining Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00) to be allocated for the Mayor to implement Capital Improvements and other projects, as determined by the City Manager.


Section 2. Authority of the City Manager. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the City Manager to do all things necessary to implement capital improvements, roadway improvements, street lighting, landscaping, home improvements and home beautification projects, and other projects as funded and allocated herein.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by a 5 - 0 vote of the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, this 14th day of April, 2015.


