

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-R-88

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE CITY ADMINISTRATION'S COMPETITIVE SELECTION OF A.C. SCHULTES OF FLORIDA, INC., AS THE LOWEST-RESPONSIVE RESPONSIBLE CONTRACTOR TO FURNISH ALL MATERIALS, EQUIPMENT, TOOLS, MACHINERY, SUPERVISION, EXPERTISE, AND SERVICES REQUIRED FOR THE REHABILITATION OF FIVE (5) BISCAYNE AQUIFER RAW WATER PRODUCTION WELLS; AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH SELECTED CONTRACTOR AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$200,000.00), IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS, CONDITIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS CONTAINED IN THE INVITATION FOR BID WINSON WATER TREATMENT PLANT REHABILITATION OF FIVE (5) BISCAYNE AQUIFER PRODUCTION WELLS IFB NO. 33-06-15; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, in July 2, 2015, the City of North Miami ("City") advertised *Invitation for Bid Winson Water Treatment Plant Rehabilitation of Five (5) Biscayne Aquifer Production Wells IFB No. 33-06-15* ("IFB"), seeking competitive sealed bids from qualified licensed and insured contractors to furnish all labor, materials, equipment, tools, machinery, supervision, expertise and services required in the rehabilitation of raw water production wells (collectively referred hereto as "Services"); and

WHEREAS, in response to the IFB, A.C. Schultes of Florida, Inc. ("Contractor"), submitted its bid and was competitively selected by City administration as the most responsive-responsible low bidder, with qualifications and references demonstrating to be the most advantageous to the City in the provision of Services; and

WHEREAS, the Contractor manifested the capability and willingness of providing Services to the City at a cost not to exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00), in accordance with the terms, conditions and specifications contained in the IFB; and

WHEREAS, City administration respectfully requests that the Mayor and City Council approve the selection of Contractor and further authorize negotiations and execution of an agreement for the completion of Services; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council find the selection of Contractor to be in the best interest of the City, and that the provision of Services under an agreement are designed to protect the public health, safety, and welfare.


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1. Selection Approval.** The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby approve the City Administration's competitive selection of A.C. Schultes of Florida, Inc., as the lowest-responsive responsible contractor to furnish all materials, equipment, tools, machinery, supervision, expertise, and services required for the rehabilitation of five (5) Biscayne Aquifer raw water production wells.

**Section 2. Authority of City Manager.** The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the City Manager to negotiate and execute an agreement with selected contractor at a cost not to exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00), in accordance with the terms, conditions and specifications contained in the *Invitation for Bid Winson Water Treatment Plant Rehabilitation of Five (5) Biscayne Aquifer Production Wells IFB No. 33-06-15*.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
