

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-R-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER AND INTERIM CITY ATTORNEY TO EXECUTE A SECOND OPTION TO RENEW PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI AND A&A DRAINAGE & VAC SERVICES, INC., FOR THE PROVISION OF VACUUM CLEANING, JETTING AND INSPECTION OF CITY OWNED STORMWATER, SANITARY SEWER STRUCTURES AND APPURTENANCES, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS, CONDITIONS, AND SPECIFICATIONS CONTAINED IN THE MAINTENANCE OF STORMWATER AND SANITARY SEWER FACILITIES REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS NO. 2013-18, AS ISSUED AND AMENDED BY THE CITY OF WESTON, FLORIDA, AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$75,000.00); PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on November 30, 2013, the City of Weston, Florida (“Weston”), issued *Maintenance of Stormwater and Sanitary Sewer Facilities Request for Proposals No. 2013-18* (“RFP”), as subsequently amended, seeking proposals from qualified contractors to provide continuing services for vacuum cleaning, jetting and inspection of, and emergency response to, city-owned stormwater, sanitary sewer structures and appurtenances including, but not limited to: catch basins, inlets, manholes, pipe outfall and pollution control devices, sanitary sewer pipes and lift stations, in accordance with the technical specifications, terms and conditions contained in the RFP (collectively referred to herein as “Services”); and

WHEREAS, on January 21, 2014, the city commission of Weston passed and adopted Resolution No. 2014-14, approving the competitive award and selection of A&A Drainage & Vac Services, Inc. (“Contractor”), as the most responsive-responsible proposer of Services; and

WHEREAS, on October 23, 2007, the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami (“City”), adopted Ordinance 1244, which authorizes the City Manager to approve the purchase of supplies, goods and/or services from current contracts of other governmental entities (“piggyback”), such as Weston; and

WHEREAS, on February 18, 2014, the City entered into a piggyback agreement with Contractor for the provision of Services in accordance with RFP requirements (“Agreement”), for an Initial Term of one (1) year and four (4) options to renew on a year-to-year basis; and

WHEREAS, upon completion of the Initial Term, City administration exercised the first of four (4) options to renew the Agreement with Contractor, ending on February 28, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the City administration desires to exercise the second of four (4) options to renew Agreement in order to maintain and extend needed Services for one (1) additional year (“Second Option”); and

WHEREAS, the term of the Second Option shall be the period commencing March 1, 2016, through February 28, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Contractor has expressed its capability, expertise and willingness to continue to perform the Services pursuant to RFP requirements for the term period provided under the Second Option; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council find that the execution of a Second Option to renew Agreement with Contractor for the provision of Services, is in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. **Authority of Interim City Manager.** The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the Interim City Manager and Interim City Attorney to execute a Second Option to renew Professional Services Agreement between the City of North Miami and A&A Drainage & Vac Services, Inc., for the provision of vacuum cleaning, jetting and inspection of City owned stormwater, sanitary sewer structures and appurtenances, in accordance with the terms, conditions, and specifications contained in the *Maintenance of Stormwater and Sanitary Sewer Facilities Request for Proposals No. 2013-18*, as issued and amended by the City of Weston, Florida , at a cost not to exceed Seventy Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00).

Section 2. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


