# Addendum to PUBLIC NOTICE

City of North Miami, Florida  
Community Planning and Development Department

A 30-day public comment period was started on **July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2017** for the City of North Miami's proposed FY 2017-2018 Annual Action Plan regarding funding to be received from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). This plan is required by HUD in order for the City to receive federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) Program funds. The allocation and distribution of grant funds at that time was based on an estimate of CDBG and HOME funds since HUD had not informed the City of their grant amounts. Recently HUD informed the City of the allocation that it will receive.

By way of this addendum, the City is informing the community of the grant amounts and the way those grants were allocated to get public comment. The grant amounts and activities highlighted below represents the City's allocation that will be included in the 2017-2018 Annual Action Plan submittal to HUD.

Please note that the activities identified in the initial draft of the plan has not changed only the amounts allocated under each category based on the City's actual grants. The comment period will continue until **August 10, 2017**.

**CDBG Program:** The City will receive **\$698,978** in grant funds for FY 2017-2018 to support the provision of decent housing, a suitable living environment, and to expand economic opportunities for low- and moderate-income persons. Funded activities must serve one of the three CDBG National Objectives: 1) to benefit low-and moderate-income persons; 2) to aid in the prevention or elimination of slum or blight; and 3) to meet a community development need of particular urgency. CDBG funding is allocated for the following activities: **1) Program Administration - \$139,795; 2) Single Family Housing Rehabilitation - \$373,536; 3) Economic Development - \$25,000; 4) Public Services - \$104,847; 5) Public Facilities (capital projects) - \$25,800; and 6) Single Family Emergency Repairs for Elderly Homeowners - \$30,000.**

**HOME Program:** The City will receive **\$208,444** in grant funds for FY 2017-2018 to provide affordable housing for households at 80% or below the area median income. HOME funds will be made available through loans, grants, and other forms of HUD approved investments. HOME funded is allocated for the following activities: **1) Program Administration - \$20,844; 2) Community Housing Development Organization (CHDO) Set-aside Program - \$31,266; 3) Single Family Housing Rehabilitation - \$133,334; 4) First Time Homebuyer Assistance - \$20,000; and 5) Tenant Based Rental Assistance (TBRA) - \$1,500.**
