PROPOSED RESOLUTION OF THE VICE MAYOR AS ACTING MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA; APPROVING THE EXECUTION OF AN EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY MANAGER; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

Councilman Galvin made a motion to approve [TAB D]; the motion was seconded by Councilwoman Keys and passed by a 4-0 vote with amendment which replaced the termination clause of Aleem Ghany's contract by article 4 section 18 of the City Charter.

PROPOSED ORDINANCE (*SECOND READING*) OF THE VICE MAYOR AS ACTING MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, CALLING FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE OFFICE OF THE MAYOR OF NORTH MIAMI DUE TO THE SUSPENSION OF MAYOR LUCIE TONDREAU BY GOVERNOR RICK SCOTT, TO BE HELD ON AUGUST 26, 2014, WITH ANY NECESSARY RUN-OFF ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 4, 2014, AS PROVIDED BY STATE LAW, THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI AND THE NORTH MIAMI CODE OF ORDINANCES; DESCRIBING PERSONS QUALIFIED TO VOTE IN SAID ELECTION, PROVIDING FOR QUALIFYING DATES, PROVIDING FOR THE PROVISION OF AND CLOSING OF REGISTRATION BOOKS, DESIGNATING HOURS AND PLACES FOR VOTING, DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO GIVE NOTICE OF THIS ORDINANCE'S ADOPTION AND TRANSMIT A CERTIFIED COPY TO THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, AND FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Councilman Galvin made a motion to approve [TAB E]; the motion was seconded by Councilwoman Keys and passed by a 4-0 vote with amendment that fixed the qualifying period for the Special Election from June 16 through June 23, 2014.
