RE: Alliance for a Healthier Generation Grant

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Mayor and Council approve the attached resolution ratifying the amendment of Fiscal Year 2013-14 Amended Revenue and Expense budgets to include the receipt and appropriation of grant funding from the Alliance for a Healthier Generation in the amount of \$2,200 to be used for after school programming throughout the City.

BACKGROUND

This Alliance for a Healthier Generation grant is for out-of-school time providers (afterschool) programs, community centers, parks & recreation facilities to create environments for young people where healthy eating options are accessible and encouraged. Healthier Generation and the City of North Miami recognizes the essential role we can play in providing youth and families the opportunity to learn and apply healthy eating skills. The funding is to enhance our efforts towards healthy food access and nutrition education for the youth participants and their families by not only providing snacks but educational materials.

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, RATIFYING AN AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2013-2014 REVENUE AND EXPENSE BUDGET TO INCLUDE THE RECEIPT AND APPROPRIATION OF GRANT FUNDING FROM THE ALLIANCE FOR A HEALTHIER GENERATION GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$2,200.00), TO BE USED FOR AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS THROUGHOUT THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami passed and adopted an annual budget in accordance with the Charter of the City of North Miami (“City”) for the Fiscal Year 2013-2014, commencing on October 1, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the City received grant funds in the amount of Two Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$2,200.00), to be used for after school programs throughout the City focusing on healthy eating options, healthy food access and nutrition education for young participants and their families (“Program”); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council desire to ratify the amendment to the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 Revenue and Expense Budget, to include the receipt and appropriation of grant funding from the Alliance for a Healthier Generation Grant, to effectuate the Program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Amendment of Budget. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby ratify an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 Revenue and Expense Budget to include the receipt and appropriation of grant funding from the Alliance for a Healthier Generation Grant in the amount of Two Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$2,200.00), to be used for after school programs throughout the City of North Miami.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
