**RE: NATIONAL RECREATION AND PARKS ASSOCIATION
OUT-OF-SCHOOL-TIME PROGRAM GRANT**

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Mayor and City Council approve the attached resolution ratifying the submittal of an application and authorizing the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate a grant from the National Recreation and Parks Association for the Out-of-School-Time Program grant.

BACKGROUND

The funds requested are to support children's health through park and recreation out-of-school time programs. The program will increase the number of healthy meals for children in low-income communities. It will also provide evidence-based, age appropriate nutrition literacy to children that create behavior change by teaching the importance of healthy eating, and the implementation of nutrition and physical activity standards. It will also increase access to healthier foods and physical activity. The total project budget is \$35,000 and the amount requested is \$35,000. There is no required match.

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI AND THE NATIONAL RECREATION AND PARKS ASSOCIATION (NRPA) FOR A GRANT FROM THE OUT OF SCHOOL TIME PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council are desirous of securing an Out of School Time Program grant from the National Recreation and Parks Association (NRPA); and

WHEREAS, the City of North Miami is requesting a grant in the amount of Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$35,000.00) in grant funds with no required match for a total project cost in the amount of Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$35,000.00); and

WHEREAS, funds will be used to increase the number of healthy meals for children in low-income communities, provide age appropriate nutrition literacy to children that will create behavior change by teaching them the importance of healthy eating, and implement nutrition and physical activity standards that increase access to healthier foods and physical activity.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Ratification of Application. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby ratify the submission of the City of North Miami's application for a grant from the National Recreation and Parks Association (NRPA) Out of School Time Program.

Section 2. Authority to City Manager and City Attorney. The City Manager and City Attorney are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute an agreement between the City of North Miami, Florida and the National Recreation and Parks Association (NRPA).

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
