RE: A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ISSUE PURCHASE ORDERS FOR THE PURCHASE OF THE FOLLOWING EQUIPMENT AND VEHICLES: TWO (2) 2016 WACKER NEUSON LTN 6L LIGHT TOWERS (SPECIFICATION #66), ONE (1) 2016 BOBCAT E20 EXCAVATOR (SPECIFICATION #37), ONE (1) 2016 BOBCAT 418 EXCAVATOR (SPECIFICATION #37), ONE (1) 2016 THOMPSON 6 INCH MOBILE PUMP (SPECIFICATION #71), FOUR (4) 2016 FORD F-250 SD PICKUP TRUCKS (F2A), AND THREE (3) 2016 FORD F-450 CREW CAB PICKUP TRUCKS (F4G), TO BE PLACED IN SERVICE BY THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, WATER & SEWER DIVISION AT AN APPROXIMATE-AGGREGATE COST OF FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$450,000.00) FROM VARIOUS COMPETITIVELY SELECTED VENDORS, PIGGYBACKING COMPETITIVE AWARDS ISSUED BY THE FLORIDA SHERIFFS ASSOCIATION, UNDER THE CAB & CHASSIS & OTHER FLEET EQUIPMENT BID AWARD NUMBER 15-13-0904 AND THE POLICE RATED, ADMINISTRATIVE, UTILITY VEHICLES, TRUCKS & VANS BID AWARD NUMBER 15-23-0904; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff is recommending that the Mayor and City Council authorize the Interim City Manager to issue purchase orders for two (2) new Wacker Neuson light towers, two (2) new Bobcat Excavators, one (1) new Thompson mobile pump and seven (7) new Ford pickup trucks at a cost not to exceed \$450,000 to the following vendors:

- Bobcat Company \$ 40,000.00
- Duval Ford \$334,000.00
- Kelly Tractor \$ 20,000.00
- Thompson Pump & Mfg. \$ 56,000.00

Council Report

BACKGROUND

Staff is utilizing the Florida Sheriff's Association and Florida Association of Counties contract numbers 15-13-0904 and 15-23-0904 to purchase the equipment and vehicles.

The equipment and vehicles being replaced would require extensive exterior, interior and/or mechanical work in order for them to remain part of the fleet. Moreover, the equipment and vehicles are all between ten and twenty years old and have exceeded their useful life term.

The replacement vehicles will provide safe and reliable transportation of staff, materials and/or equipment to their job sites. Funding for the equipment was approved in the FY15 budget and re-appropriated to the FY16 budget. Funding for the vehicles was approved in the FY16 budget. The funds are currently allocated for this purchase in the following accounts:

- 420-10-644000-536-605-000; and
- 420-10-650000-536-605-000.

WHEREAS, effective on October 1, 2015, the Florida Sheriffs Association & Florida Association of Counties (“Association”) issued two (2) competitive bid awards resulting from the *Cab & Chassis & Other Fleet Equipment Bid Award Number 15-13-0904* and the *Police Rated, Administrative, Utility Vehicles, Trucks & Vans Bid Award Number 15-23-0904* (collectively referred to herein as the “Award”), on behalf of participating sheriff’s offices and local governmental agencies of the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Award is designed provide participating agencies and local municipal governments, with a mechanism for increasing their purchasing power by offering the most economically priced cars, trucks, vans and equipment, tailored to the agency’s specific requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Association guarantees participating agencies and local municipal governments, the availability of competitive pricing under the Award by selected vendors (“Vendors”), for the period commencing on the effective date of the Award through September 30, 2016, as long as vehicles and equipment are available in Vendors’ inventories; and

WHEREAS, the City administration has identified the need for the following equipment and vehicles: two (2) 2016 Wacker Neuson LTN 6L Light Towers (Specification #66), one (1) 2016 Bobcat E20 Excavator (Specification #37), one (1) 2016 Bobcat 418 Excavator (Specification #37), one (1) 2016 Thompson 6 inch Mobile Pump (Specification #71), four (4) 2016 Ford F-250 SD Pickup Trucks (F2A), and three (3) 2016 Ford F-450 Crew Cab Pickup Trucks (F4G) (collectively referred to herein as “Vehicles”); and

WHEREAS, the Vehicles purchased will be placed in service by the Public Works Department, Water & Sewer Division; and

WHEREAS, the Vehicles will be purchased at an approximate-aggregate cost of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$450,000.00), from the following competitively selected Vendors: Bobcat Company, Duval Ford, Kelly Tractor, and Thompson Pump & Manufacturing; and

WHEREAS, on October 23, 2007, the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, adopted Ordinance 1244, which authorizes the City Manager to approve the purchase of supplies, goods and/or services from current contracts of other governmental entities (“piggyback”), such as the Florida Sheriffs Association; and

WHEREAS, the Interim City Manager has determined that it is in the City’s best interest to piggyback the Award in order to expeditiously purchase Vehicles for immediate public-service use, while utilizing the most cost-effective means currently available to the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Authority of City Manager. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the Interim City Manager or his designee to issue Purchase Orders for the purchase of the following equipment and vehicles: two (2) 2016 Wacker Neuson LTN 6L Light Towers (Specification #66), one (1) 2016 Bobcat E20 Excavator (Specification #37), one (1) 2016 Bobcat 418 Excavator (Specification #37), one (1) 2016 Thompson 6 inch Mobile Pump (Specification #71), four (4) 2016 Ford F-250 SD Pickup Trucks (F2A), and three (3) 2016 Ford F-450 Crew Cab Pickup Trucks (F4G), to be placed in service by the Public Works Department, Water & Sewer Division at an approximate-aggregate cost of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$450,000.00) from various competitively selected vendors, piggybacking

competitive awards issued by the Florida Sheriffs Association, under the *Cab & Chassis & Other Fleet Equipment Bid Award Number 15-13-0904* and the *Police Rated, Administrative, Utility Vehicles, Trucks & Vans Bid Award Number 15-23-0904*.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
