RECOMMENDATION

That the City Council adopt a resolution authorizing the City of North Miami to enter into an Agreement with Retiring Police Major Trevor Shinn for possession of his City-issued firearm (Sig Sauer 229, serial number AF10652) subsequent to his retirement on August 13, 2016.

BACKGROUND

Major Trevor Shinn has been employed by the City of North Miami Police Department for 27 years and is retiring in good standing. Major Shinn agrees to indemnify and hold the City of North Miami and the Police Department harmless from and against any and all claims of action, causes of action, damages and losses arising from or relating in any way to said firearm.

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A CITY-ISSUED FIREARM TO RETIRED POLICE MAJOR TREVOR SHINN IN RECOGNITION OF TWENTY-SEVEN (27) YEARS OF SERVICE TO THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI AND THE NORTH MIAMI POLICE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Trevor Shinn was a Police Major with the City of North Miami Police Department, who retired on August 13, 2016 with twenty-seven (27) years of service as a sworn law enforcement officer; and

WHEREAS, Retired Police Major Shinn was assigned a service firearm, which he has utilized during his career as a Police Officer with the North Miami Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Retired Police Major Shinn has met Florida Department of Law Enforcement qualification standards with said firearm; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Law Enforcement allows retired police officers/detectives to carry concealed firearms because it promotes public safety in the state and local municipalities; and

WHEREAS, Police Major Shinn retired in good standing and wishes to retain possession of his city-issued firearm (Sig Sauer P229, 40 caliber, serial number AF10652) effective on the date of his retirement, August 13, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the City of North Miami has no further use of the described firearm and wishes to award retiring Police Major Shinn with the firearm in recognition of his service to the City of North Miami and as encouragement to other officers/detectives to have long term employment in the department.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. **Authority to Award.** The Police Chief, by and through the City Manager, is authorized to award to Police Major Shinn, upon his retirement, his city-issued firearm in

recognition of his twenty-seven (27) years of distinguished service to the City of North Miami and the North Miami Police Department.

Section 2. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

Whereas, the undersigned was assigned a service firearm, which he has utilized during his career as a Police Officer with the North Miami Police Department; and

Whereas, the Florida Department of Law Enforcement allows retired police officers/detectives to carry concealed firearms because it promotes public safety in the state and local municipalities; and

Whereas, the undersigned has met the Florida Department of Law Enforcement qualification standards with said firearm; and

Whereas, the undersigned retired in good standing and wishes to retain possession of his city issued firearm (Sig Sauer P229, 40 caliber, serial number AF10652), effective on the effective date of this resolution; and

Whereas, the City of North Miami has no further use of the described firearm and wishes to award the undersigned with the firearm in recognition of his service to the City of North Miami and as encouragement to other officers to have long term employment in the department.

The undersigned hereby agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the City of North Miami, Florida and the City of North Miami Police Department from and against any and all claims of action, causes of action, damages and losses arising from or relating in any way to possession and usage of said firearm regardless if claims of action, causes of action, damages and losses are suffered by the undersigned or a third party.

The undersigned agrees to abide by any and all laws of the State of Florida governing possession of a firearm by a retired police officer including, but not limited to, taking any courses required to stay proficient in the use of said firearm.

The undersigned further agrees to carry in his possession identification as a retired City of North Miami law enforcement officer (i.e. retired police officer) while in possession of such firearm.

The undersigned, his assigns, successors and heirs, waives any claims, causes of action or losses, which he has or may have in the future against the City of North Miami and/or the City of North Miami Police Department regarding the award of said firearm.
