RE: **UNIVERSITY OF SOUTH FLORIDA - PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE SAFETY GRANT PROGRAM**

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Mayor and City Council approve the attached resolution ratifying the submittal of a grant application and authorizing the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate and execute an agreement between the city of North Miami and the University of South Florida for the Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety grant program.

BACKGROUND

The city of North Miami submitted a grant application to the University of South Florida for the Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety Program in the amount of \$67,200 with no required match. The funds will be used to promote conditions of safety and effective pedestrian and bicycle travel in the City. The North Miami Police Department (NMPD) will educate the community on the importance of traffic laws and regulations.

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI AND THE UNIVERSITY OF SOUTH FLORIDA TO SECURE A GRANT IN SUPPORT OF THE HIGH VISIBILITY ENFORCEMENT FOR PEDESTRIANS AND BICYCLE SAFETY PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of North Miami (“City”) applied for a grant from the University of South Florida’s High Visibility Enforcement for Pedestrians and Bicycle Safety Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the City requested funds in the amount of Sixty-Seven Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$67,200.00) with no required match; and

WHEREAS, funds will be utilized to promote conditions for safe and effective pedestrian and bicycle travel in the City by conducting dynamic high visibility on-street law enforcement details along the subject corridor and by evaluating tactics and operations in an effort to change vehicle, pedestrian and bicycle behavior; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council wish to ratify the submittal of a grant application as well as to fully authorize the negotiation and execution of an agreement for grant funds between the City and the University of South Florida.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Ratification of Submission of Grant Application. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby ratify the submission of the City of North Miami’s application for the High Visibility Enforcement for Pedestrians and Bicycle Safety Program Grant.

Section 2. Authority to City Manager and City Attorney. The City Manager and City Attorney are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute an agreement between the City of North Miami, Florida and the University of South Florida to obtain grant funds.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
