**RECOMMENDATION**

Upon Mayor and City Council directive to the City Manager at the January 24, 2012 council meeting, to piggyback on an existing Solid Waste contract with other municipalities.

**BACKGROUND**

On September 27, 2011, Mayor and Council directed City administration to investigate the advantages and disadvantages of privatizing commercial and residential sanitation services, including bulk trash collection.

On November 22, 2011, Pro Resource LLC presented their report to Mayor and City Council.

At the subsequent December 13<sup>th</sup> Council Meeting, City Administrators were instructed to obtain comparison pricing from private service providers.

At the January 24, 2012 council meeting, Mayor and City Council gave direction to the City Manager to piggyback on an existing Solid Waste contract with other municipalities.

Several contracts were reviewed and the City Manager selected to piggyback with the City of Miramar's contract.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT, IN SUBSTANTIALLY THE ATTACHED FORM, BETWEEN THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI AND WASTE PRO OF FLORIDA, INC., TO PIGGYBACK THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MIRAMAR, FLORIDA, AND WASTE PRO OF FLORIDA, INC., FOR THE PROVISION OF WASTE MANAGEMENT SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND ALL OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, on July 21, 2010, the City of Miramar, Florida (“Miramar”), issued *Request For Proposals – Sanitation Services Franchise #10-07-18* (“RFP”), seeking a qualified, insured and experienced contractor to provide Miramar with Solid Waste and Recycling Collection Services to residential and commercial establishments, in accordance with the terms, conditions, requirements and specifications contained in the RFP (“Services”); and

**WHEREAS**, in response to the RFP, Waste Pro of Florida, Inc., (“Contractor”) submitted a written proposal and was competitively selected as having established the criteria, qualifications, and references most advantageous to Miramar; and

**WHEREAS**, on November 29, 2010, the City Commission of the City of Miramar adopted Resolution Number 11-41, approving the ranking and selection of Contractor as the top-ranked firm to provide Services, pursuant to the RFP; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 26, 2011, the City Commission of the City of Miramar adopted Resolution Number 11-53, approving the award of a five-year Solid Waste and Recycling Collection Services Agreement, with the option to renew for two (2) additional three-year terms; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 23, 2007, the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami (“City”), adopted Ordinance No. 1244, which authorizes the City Manager to approve the purchase of supplies, goods and/or services from current contracts of other governmental entities (“piggyback”), such as Miramar; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 24, 2012, the Mayor and City Council amended Chapter 9 of the City Code of Ordinances, to allow for the collection and removal of garbage, trash and solid waste, including recyclable materials, by one or more private waste collectors; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to piggyback the Miramar contract, to expeditiously obtain Services throughout the City without compromising the quality of sanitation services, while employing the most cost effective means available; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, have determined that piggybacking the Miramar contract for the collection and disposal of garbage and waste substances at a competitive rate, is in the best interest of the citizens and residents of the City of North Miami.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1. Authority of City Manager.** The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement, in substantially the attached form, between the City of North Miami and Waste Pro of Florida, Inc., to piggyback the contract between the City of Miramar, Florida, and Waste Pro of Florida, Inc., for the provision of Waste Management Services.

**Section 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
