Dr. Rudolph Moise is the President and CEO of Comprehensive Health Center, LLC a large primary health care practice with centers in Dade, Broward and Central Florida. He practices family medicine and pain management. He is also the CEO of Physician Access Urgent Care Group (PAUC), a Managed Service Organization (MSO), which manages medical practices in South and Central Florida. Dr. Moise has received multiple awards from several organizations around the country. In 2005 the South Florida Business journal named him one of the five finalists for the “Best Physician of The Year” award. He is a member of multiple boards, including The Dade County Medical Association, United Way of Miami Dade County, Jackson Memorial Foundation. He recently retired from the Air Force Reserve after 21 years of honorable service as a Colonel and Flight Surgeon. He was recently appointed Ambassador at large for Investment in Haiti. Dr. Moise and his wife Mirjam have two school-aged children, Rudy Jr. and Maya.

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, REVISING THE GUIDELINES FOR THE SELECTION OF HONOREES TO THE CITIZENS' HALL OF FAME; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, in Resolution 2013-15, the Mayor and City Council adopted guidelines for the selection of Honorees to the Citizens' Hall of Fame; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council would like to revise the guidelines for the selection of honorees to the Citizens' Hall of Fame.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals in the whereas clauses are true and correct and incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 2. Adoption of revised procedures and guidelines. The Mayor and City Council hereby revise the guidelines for the selection and induction of honorees to the Citizens' Hall of Fame. A copy of the revised procedures and guidelines is attached as "Exhibit A".

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.



EXHIBIT "A"

Revised Procedures for Selection and Induction of Honorees into the Citizens' Hall of Fame

The Mayor and City Council hereby re-establish guidelines for the selection and induction of honorees into the City of North Miami Citizens' Hall of Fame.

I. Qualifications for Eligibility.

1. Only the members of the City Council shall be eligible to nominate an individual for induction into the Citizens' Hall of Fame.
2. A nominee for induction into the Citizens' Hall of Fame must either be a current or past resident of the City of North Miami; a current or past business owner in the City; or a person who has substantially contributed to the well-being or advancement to the City of North Miami or its residents as a place to live, work or play.
3. Nomination shall be submitted in writing to the City Manager and include all supportive evidence of reasons honoree is deserving of induction.
4. The City Council shall vote on the nominee at the next regular City Council meeting.
5. Any nominee receiving a majority vote of the City Council shall be scheduled for induction. All efforts should be made to have induction ceremonies coincide with other major City events.
6. A plaque inscribed with the name of each inductee shall be hung in a designated area of city hall in order to permit public recognition for the members of the Citizens' Hall of Fame.
7. Elected officials shall not be eligible for induction during the time of their terms of office or for a period of three (3) years thereafter.
8. Posthumous nomination and induction into the Citizens' Hall of Fame shall be permitted.
9. Beginning August 2013, the Mayor and/or City Councilperson shall be limited to one nominee per term in office.
