RE: A Resolution of the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, authorizing the City Manager to purchase Sodium Hypochlorite, a chemical compound required for the operation of the City's water treatment plant in producing the highest quality of potable water, by piggybacking the City of Ocala, Florida, procurement award under Invitation to Bid 10-047 - Sodium Hypochlorite, with Allied Universal Corp., at a cost not to exceed One Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$115,000.00) per year, with four (4) renewable yearly-term periods; Providing for an effective date and for all other purposes.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff is recommending that the Mayor and Council authorize the City Manager to piggyback the City of Ocala, FL procurement award under Invitation to Bid 10-047 for the purchase of Sodium Hypochlorite with Allied Universal Corp. at a cost not to exceed \$115,000.

BACKGROUND

The Winston Water Plant requires Sodium Hypochlorite, a chemical compound required to disinfect the water during the water treatment process. Disinfection is an integral part of the treatment process mandated by Federal, State and local regulatory agencies. The water plant uses approximately 40,000 gallons of sodium hypochlorite quarterly.

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE SODIUM HYPOCHLORITE, A CHEMICAL COMPOUND REQUIRED FOR THE OPERATION OF THE CITY'S WATER TREATMENT PLANT IN PRODUCING THE HIGHEST QUALITY OF POTABLE WATER, BY PIGGYBACKING THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA, PROCUREMENT AWARD UNDER INVITATION TO BID 10-047 - SODIUM HYPOCHLORITE, WITH ALLIED UNIVERSAL CORP., AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$115,000.00) PER YEAR, WITH FOUR (4) RENEWABLE YEARLY-TERM PERIODS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on July 26, 2010, the City of Ocala, Florida, ("Ocala"), issued *Invitation to Bid ITB 10-047 – Sodium Hypochlorite* ("ITB"), seeking a qualified, insured, licensed, and experienced contractor to furnish and deliver Sodium Hypochlorite in accordance with the technical specifications, terms and conditions contained in the ITB ("Services"); and

WHEREAS, in response to the ITB, Allied Universal Corp. ("Contractor"), submitted a written bid, which was competitively selected as having established the price, criteria, qualifications, and references most advantageous to Ocala; and

WHEREAS, on September 10, 2010, Ocala entered into an agreement with Contractor for the procurement of Services, pursuant to the requirements of the ITB ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, on September 4, 2014, Ocala and Contractor executed *Amendment #4 – Renewal Purchase of Liquid Sodium Hypochlorite*, extending the Agreement for an additional period commencing October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2015; and

WHEREAS, October 23, 2007, the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami ("City"), adopted Ordinance No. 1244, which authorizes the City Manager to approve the purchase of supplies, goods and/or services from current contracts of other governmental entities ("piggyback"), such as Ocala; and

WHEREAS, City administration respectfully requests to piggyback the Ocala Agreement, as amended, to expeditiously secure and obtain Services for the City's water

treatment plant, and thereby utilizing the most cost-effective means available to the City in the procurement of an estimated yearly volume of One Hundred Forty Thousand (140,000) gallons of liquid Sodium Hypochlorite; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council find that piggybacking the Ocala Agreement, as amended, for the purchase and delivery of liquid Sodium Hypochlorite at a competitive rate, and in accordance with the technical specifications, terms and conditions contained in the ITB, is in the best interest of the City and all water service area consumers.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Authority of City Manager. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the City Manager to purchase Sodium Hypochlorite, a chemical compound required for the operation of the City's water treatment plant in producing the highest quality of potable water, by piggybacking the City of Ocala, Florida, procurement award under *Invitation to Bid 10-047 - Sodium Hypochlorite*, with Allied Universal Corp., at a cost not to exceed One Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$115,000.00) per year, with four (4) renewable yearly-term periods.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
