The following question(s) were submitted and becomes a part of the bid document:

Q.1 Has a Geotechnical Report been done recently for this facility? If yes, can a copy be provided?

A. No it has not

Q.2 Are conceptual renderings required with the RFP submittal package?

A. Yes

Q.3 Per your instructions on page 2 of the RFP, we are required to submit 1 original, 1 CD and 5 copies of our proposal. Per your instructions on page 21 of the RFP we are required to submit 1 original, 1 CD and 3 copies of our proposal. Question: How many copies of our proposal are we required to submit?

A. Five (5) copies are required

Q.4 We reviewed the plans for the Rucks Park, however, it is mentioned that there is sports lighting, however, I am unable to locate the specs. Would you please direct me to the specs for sports lighting.

A. Section 2.5 states "All sports lighting shall be MUSCO Lighting or equivalent subject to the approval by the City at its sole discretion". The type and number of fields has not been finalized at this time. The City is open to designs that will be proposed by the various architects that may be interested in the project. In addition to lighting the fields, the City will be looking for lighting on the courts as well.
