To All Respondents:

It is the Respondent's responsibility to assure receipt of all addenda. The Respondent should verify with the designated Contracting Officer prior to submitting a proposal that all addenda have been received.

This addendum is issued to modify the previously issued RFP documents and/or given for informational purposes, and is hereby made a part of the RFP documents.

1. Our law firm does federal lobbying for the City of North Miami in Washington, D.C. Would we be precluded from representing a respondent in a legal capacity?

A. Yes, the City would consider it a conflict.

2. If the answer is "yes" to No. 1., Would a lawyer at our firm be precluded from participating in a respondent team as a Joint Venture principal if the individual was not engaged as a lawyer by the Joint Venture (and, accordingly, the law firm had no contractual relationship with the Joint Venture)?

A. Although the City's Code of Ordinances does not specifically make it a conflict, we would refer them to the Florida Bar Canon of ethics as it relates to doing business with a client for any potential conflict.
