To All Respondents:

It is the Respondent's responsibility to assure receipt of all addenda. The Respondent should verify with the designated Contracting Officer prior to submitting a proposal that all addenda have been received.

This addendum is issued to modify the previously issued RFP documents and/or given for informational purposes, and is hereby made a part of the RFP documents.

1. Given our limited representation, would the City be willing to grant a waiver to the conflict so that we can participate as legal counsel on one of the responding teams?

A. The waiver would be limited. It would not include any litigation or adversarial matter.

2. As part of my due diligence on the project I understand the following:

That ES Consultants, Inc. (ESC) prepared the last Stormwater Master Plan

That ESC completed the landfill gas management design for the second phase of construction

That ESC cannot team with a developer at this time because they are under contract with the city; however, it's my understanding that they are permitted to be contracted with the selected developer.

A. The answer to all three questions is yes. ES cannot team with a developer at this time because of the Cone of Silence. ES is not allowed to communicate with a potential developer. However, there is nothing that would prohibit ES Consultants to team with the selected developer after the RFP process is complete.
