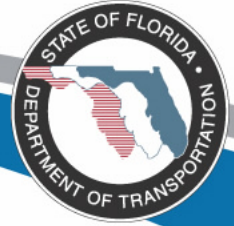


# Roadway Project Notification

## Florida Department of Transportation District Six

### State Road (SR) 7/NW 7 Avenue



**SR 7/NW 7 Avenue from NW 117 Street to NW 131 Street North Miami, Miami-Dade County**  
**Project Identification Number: 428054-1-52-01**

#### **ESTIMATED COST OF THE PROJECT**

\$1.5 million

#### **DATES OF THE**

Construction is expected to begin in November 2013 and last about 200 days.

#### **POSSIBLE EFFECTS DURING CONSTRUCTION**

- Temporary lane closures during non-rush hours will have minimal effects on traffic
- Temporary lane and sidewalk closures

#### **MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC**

Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects of construction on the community.

**Driveways and entrances to businesses and homes will stay open.**

**Any driveway work will be coordinated with each property owner and done at a mutually convenient time.**

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six is developing the design for a Project to repave, restripe, landscape and expand the road along NW 7 Avenue in North Miami, Miami-Dade County:

#### **PROJECT DETAILS**

- Repaving, resurfacing and widening of the road from NW 117 Street to NW 119 Street to establish a concrete traffic separator for a protected left turn lane from northbound SR 7 to westbound NW 119 Street
- Extending the northbound left turn lane to reduce congestion at:  
NW 119th Street                      NW 121 Street  
NW 125th Street                      NW 131st Street
- Extending the southbound left turn lane to reduce congestion at:  
NW 119th Street                      NW 122nd Street  
NW 125th Street                      NW 126th Street
- Converting the concrete traffic separator to northbound and southbound to reduce the number of crashes at:  
NW 121st Street                      NW 129th Street
- Converting the concrete traffic separator to southbound only to reduce the number of crashes at:  
NW 123rd Street                      NW 126th Street                      NW 127th Street
- Converting the concrete traffic separator to northbound only to reduce the number of crashes at:  
NW 124th Street                      NW 130th Street
- Closing the concrete traffic separator at NW 118 and NW 120 Streets
- Upgrading the traffic signal on the eastbound and westbound lanes at NW 125 Street and widening of the west lane to provide two through lanes, a left turn, and a receiving westbound lane
- Installing a countdown pedestrian signal at NW 119 and NW 125 Street and realigning traffic signals for the new lanes at these intersections
- Replacing the traffic signal poles at NW 119 Street and NW 125 Street as necessary
- Replacing the traffic signal for the northbound lanes at NW 125 Street and realigning the southbound traffic signal at this intersection
- Installing landscaping along the road
