The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six is developing the design for an intersection safety project along SR 924/NW 119 Street at NW 7 Avenue, NW 10 Avenue, NW 22 Avenue and NW 27 Avenue in the City of North Miami, Miami-Dade County.

PROJECT DETAILS

SR 924/NW 119 Street and NW 27 Avenue

- Lengthening left turn lanes at the northbound and eastbound approaches
- Closing the median between turn lanes at NW 118 Street

SR 924/NW 119 Street and NW 22 Avenue

- Repaving and restriping the road and installing a median between travel lanes
- Widening and lengthening left turn lanes

SR 924/NW119 Street and NW 10 Avenue

- Installing an eastbound and westbound realignment between left turn lanes and travel lanes
- Repaving and restriping the road and lengthening left turn lanes

SR 924/NW119 Street and NW 7 Avenue

- Installing an eastbound and westbound realignment between left turn lanes
- Extending the eastbound and westbound left turn lanes
- Repaving and restriping the road

- Temporary lane closures during non-rush hours will have minimal effects on traffic
- Temporary sidewalk closures

Work will be done in phases to reduce effects of construction on the community

Driveways and entrances to businesses and homes will stay open at all times.

Any driveway work will be coordinated with each property owner and done at a mutually convenient time
