General Information

1. Refund Policies

General: Our policy is to provide a 100% refund for anyone who submits a written request to the administrative office prior to the start of an activity. Any written refund requests received after the first day of an activity will be processed with a \$20 administrative fee. After the third day of an activity, there will be **no refunds**. There will be no refunds issued for materials/supplies purchased for an activity. This policy does not apply to one day programs, athletic leagues, special events, adult trips or facility rentals.

One Day Programs, Athletic Leagues and Special Events: Our policy is to provide a 100% refund to anyone who submits a written request to the administrative office a minimum of one week prior to the start of an activity. **No refunds** will be granted within a week of an activity.

Adult Trips: Cancellation requests must be received by the administrative office a minimum of three days prior to the trip. A credit will be applied to your account for use towards a future trip or activity. **No refunds** will be granted within three days of the trip.

Facility Rentals: Please refer to the facility rental application for details.

2. **Proof of Residency** - Proof of residency is required in order to receive the resident rate. (City of North Miami water bill or FPL bill.)

3. **Registration Policy** - A Birth Certificate is required for each child registered. Additionally, only parents and legal guardians are permitted to register their children. Parents must show valid identification at the time of registration.

4. **Returned Check Policy** - For each returned check, the City will assess a service fee of \$20, pursuant to Florida Statute 166.251, 1991. No payment by check shall be accepted if a returned check was received from an individual's bank during the past 24 months.

5. **Availability of Space** - All activities, programs and facilities are first-come, first-serve. Each program/activity session must be registered for in advance. Activities with multiple sessions can be registered for one session at a time or a combination of all sessions at once. Facilities must be reserved at least 30 days in advance.

Check out some of the accomplishments:

- Our Parks & Recreation department has been in the forefront in educating our users of our "HEALTHY PLACES, HEALTHY PEOPLE!" initiative.
- Mayor's Monthly Bike rides – Community wellness improvement

- Bike racks placed throughout the entire city both in municipal facilities as well as at businesses and implementing a Farmer's Market for 2012, both (Grant funded through the Miami Dade County Health Department as part of this national effort) in partnership with our Community Planning & Development division.
- Implemented edible garden projects and healthy vending machines into our park facilities, new and existing.
