Note: If you wish to conveniently register online and you do not have an account with us, you (parents and/or guardians) must first come to the Parks and Recreation Administrative Office with proof of North Miami Residency (utility bill) and birth certificate(s) to set up your account.

General Information

1. The North Miami Parks and Recreation Department does not accept cash payments for facility rentals. Payments may be made by money order, cashiers check or personal check. For facility rentals, Personal Checks will not be accepted within 45 days of event date. (drivers license required for personal checks)

2. Refund Policies

General: Our policy is to provide a 100% refund for anyone who submits a written request to the administrative office prior to the start of an activity. Any written refund requests received after the first day of an activity will be processed with a \$20 administrative fee. After the third day of an activity, there will be no refunds. There will be no refunds issued for materials or supplies purchased for an activity. This policy does not apply to one day programs, athletic leagues, special events, adult trips or facility rentals.

One Day Programs, Athletic Leagues and Special Events: Our policy is to provide a 100% refund to anyone who submits a written request to the administrative office a minimum of one week prior to the start of an activity. No refunds will be granted within a week of an activity.

Adult Trips: Cancellation requests must be received by the administrative office a minimum of two days prior to the trip. A credit will be applied to your account for use towards a future trip or activity. No refunds will be granted within two days of the trip.

Facility Rentals: Refer to the facility rental application or call the office for details.

3. Proof of Residency - Proof of residency is required in order to receive the resident rate. (City of North Miami water bill or FPL bill.)

4. Registration Policy - A birth certificate is required for each child registered. Additionally, only parents and legal guardians are permitted to register their children. Parents must show valid identification at the time of registration.

5. Returned Check Policy - For each returned check, the City will assess a service fee of \$20, pursuant to Florida Statute 166.251, 1991. No payment by check shall be accepted if a returned check was received from an individual's bank during the past 24 months.

6. Availability of Space - All activities, programs and facilities are first-come, first-serve. Each program/activity session must be registered in advance. Activities with multiple sessions can be registered one session at a time or a combination of all sessions at once. Facilities must be reserved at least 30 days in advance.

* Mail-in or Drop Box registrations are not permitted!

FRPA Facilities Showcase Recipient

The City of North Miami was recognized in the winter 2014 issue of the Florida Recreation and Park Association Journal for its renovations to the Claude Pepper Park tennis courts. The following information was published in the journal.

Requests from taxpayers and longtime users of the tennis center in Claude Pepper Park prompted the city council and mayor of the City of North Miami to provide funding to renovate and upgrade the facility.

Workers patched low areas and small cracks with a fiberglass membrane. Next came the application of one coat of an acrylic resurfacer followed by two coats of surface acrylic court paint in blue and dark green. The department also replaced and reinstalled

posts and nets for each court. Other improvements included the installation of more than 6,000 square feet of windscreen, the addition of four shaded cabanas and the surface recoating of the sidewalk between the courts. A mural on the walls surrounding the tennis courts adds color and interest to the area.

As a result of the additions and upgrades, the tennis center has seen an increase in annual memberships over the past two years. Community members are returning to the courts and potential players are inquiring about lessons. Adding shaded court structures has increased patron participation and court usage during non-peak hours.


