General Information

1. The North Miami Parks & Recreation Department does not accept cash payments for registrations and/or facility rentals. Payments may be made by Money Order, Cashiers Check, or Personal Check. For Facility Rentals, Personal Checks will not be accepted within 45 days of event date. (Drivers license required for Personal Checks)

2. *Refund Policies*

General: Our policy is to provide a 100% refund for anyone who submits a written request to the administrative office prior to the start of an activity. Any written refund requests received after the first day of an activity will be processed with a \$20 administrative fee. After the third day of an activity, there will be **no refunds**. There will be no refunds issued for materials or supplies purchased for an activity. This policy does not apply to one day programs, athletic leagues, special events, adult trips or facility rentals.

One Day Programs, Athletic Leagues and Special Events: Our policy is to provide a 100% refund to anyone who submits a written request to the administrative office a minimum of one week prior to the start of an activity. **No refunds** will be granted within a week of an activity.

Adult Trips: Cancellation requests must be received by the administrative office a minimum of three days prior to the trip. A credit will be applied to your account for use towards a future trip or activity. **No refunds** will be granted within three days of the trip.

Facility Rentals: Please refer to the facility rental application or call the office for details.

3. *Proof of Residency* - Proof of residency is required in order to receive the resident rate. (City of North Miami water bill or FPL bill.)

4. *Registration Policy* - A Birth Certificate is required for each child registered. Additionally, only parents and legal guardians are permitted to register their children. Parents must show valid identification at the time of registration.

5. *Returned Check Policy* - For each returned check, the City will assess a service fee of \$20, pursuant to Florida Statute 166.251, 1991. No payment by check shall be accepted if a returned check was received from an individual's bank during the past 24 months.

6. *Availability of Space* - All activities, programs and facilities are first-come, first-serve. Each program/activity session must be registered for in advance. Activities with multiple sessions can be registered for one session at a time or a combination of all sessions at once. Facilities must be reserved at least 30 days in advance.

* Dates, times and fees subject to change. Mail-in or Drop Box registrations are not permitted!

NORTH MIAMI'S \$54 MILLION ASSET

The City of North Miami has been a Tree City USA for 22 consecutive years. Tree City status is a national designation from the Arbor Day Foundation and dictates that municipalities meet very stringent requirements for the award.

Being a Tree City has countless benefits, least of which is pride in continuing to contribute to an environmental sustainability program that directly benefits the community and the world as a whole. Properly cared for trees are growing assets to our community reaching as much as four times their initial investment. A large tree will provide in excess of \$5,000 in environmental benefits over its lifetime; that's a 400% return on investment! A healthy urban forest can provide many benefits such as higher property values, lower crime rates, lower energy bills and healthier neighborhoods through the removal of carbon dioxide. The City has over 14,000 swale trees that capture approximately 1 million gallons of rain water annually that would otherwise erode soils and overload storm drains. The current value of these trees is estimated at \$54 million.

Over the last few years, we have found that residents are removing trees with no intentions of replacing them as required by the City's Tree Preservation Ordinance. The City has a formal tree removal permitting process which has specific guidelines for removing trees. Most of the time, residents' complaints can be resolved by city forces making the necessary corrective changes.
