



Call for Ideas

- The City of North Miami is looking for innovative design ideas from architectural, landscape design, and urban design students to support its conceptual master plan process for the redevelopment of the city's downtown area
- The criteria is to create design concepts for civic spaces in the downtown not limited to but may include the (1) MOCA Plaza, (2) NE 8th between NE 125th & NE 123rd, (3) NE 8th Ave civic corridor, (4) the median at Dixie and NE 7th Ave, and (5) median on Dixie and NE 132nd St.
- On April 17th 2014 at 6pm the City of North Miami will be hosting a community forum at The Gwen Margolis Center located at 1590 N.E. 123rd ST to discuss plans for the city's downtown redevelopment initiative as well as solicit input from the public
