## GENERAL INFORMATION

- CAMP HOURS:** **8:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.** We offer extended camp hours that allow you to drop your child off as early as **7:30 a.m.** and provides extended pick up times until **6:30 p.m.** Any child picked up after 6:00 p.m. and is not registered for extended hours will be charged \$5.00 for every 15 minutes after the closing time (this applies to those registered for extended hours who are picked up after 6:30 p.m.) *If a child is picked up late excessively, they will be dismissed from camp.*
- SIGN IN/OUT:** Children **must be signed in** at drop off time and **signed out** at pick up time, every day. Please make contact with the program staff at the start of each day, there may be field trip information or program flyers available for you. Notify the Camp Leader if someone other than you will be picking up the child. If your child will be riding their bike or walking to and/or from camp, we require a letter to keep on file.
- LUNCH:** The Free Lunch Program is available to all campers, if you bring a bag lunch please label the bags and lunch boxes. Refrigeration is not available; however our facility is air conditioned. Campers are encouraged to pack their lunch in disposable bags, especially on field trip days.
- CLOTHING:** Participants will be issued a camp T-shirt. **CHILDREN MUST WEAR CAMP T-SHIRTS ON FIELD TRIP DAYS!** Campers should dress in cool comfortable clothing on a daily basis, and should bring sunscreen and a hat. Many of our activities are outdoors!
- FIELD TRIPS:** **BE SURE TO CHECK THE BOARD FOR DETAILS ON FIELD TRIPS.**
- On water trips children will need a swimsuit (no cutoffs), towel, and a bag to keep everything together. **Please label everything!** Camp and Aquatics Staff are not responsible for items left or lost in the lockers and locker rooms.
- On certain trips campers will be able to purchase lunch from field trip site concession stands and/or restaurants.
- ANY CHILD WITH DISCIPLINE PROBLEMS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED ON FUTURE FIELD TRIPS.**
- DISCIPLINE:** Parents will be notified. If disciplinary problems continue, the following actions will be taken:  
1) 1 day suspension 2) 1 week suspension 3) Dismissed from camp.
- MEDICAL:** Please advise us if your child has any medical condition, is taking any medicine or has a behavioral condition. If your child is on any medication, please send in a letter and notify the camp leader.
- Please be advised the City of North Miami Parks and Recreation Department ***does not allow*** summer camp staff to administer medications to participants, this includes applying sunscreen or mosquito repellent. *If your child takes medication of any sort, please arrange a reminder routine with your child.*
- HURRICANE:** In the event that Miami-Dade county comes under a Hurricane watch, all recreation programs will be cancelled until further notice. This includes our Summer Camp programs. Please monitor local broadcast news for hurricane status throughout the day and evening. Once the Hurricane watch is lifted, programs will resume as normal.
- PERSONAL ITEMS:** The City of North Miami encourages campers to leave jewelry, valuables, and toys at home as we are not responsible for them.
- IMPORTANT:** If at any time your child's registration information changes, (phone numbers, address, etc.) please let the Camp Leader know. This information is important in case of emergency or parent contact.
