THE LEGAL COUNSEL EXPLAINED THE CASE AND CLARIFIED THE DISCOVERY OF A TYPOGRAPHICAL ERROR WITH THE DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS. THE SUSPENSION WAS FOR 80 HRS RATHER THAN 80 DAYS AS 1<sup>ST</sup> MENTIONED AND 4HRS OF IMPLICIT BIASED TRAINING. BOARD DISCUSSED THAT THE ACTION WAS FAIR AND THAT THEY SUPPORT THE DECISION OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT DISCIPLINARY DECISION.

South Florida Police Benevolent Association, Mike Helman – provided his explanation and synopsis of the rationale regarding the disciplinary actions and stated that it was basically a conflict of perspective that caused the disciplinary actions.
