CITY OF NORTH MIAMI
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG)
HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM (HOME)
PROGRAM YEAR 2021-2022 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN**

The City of North Miami (“City”) is an “entitlement” community eligible to receive assistance from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”) through the Community Development Block Grant (“CDBG”) and HOME Investment Partnerships (“HOME”) programs. The City is expected to receive **\$788,498.00** in CDBG funds and **\$300,531.00** in HOME funds for Fiscal Year (FY) 2021-2022. CDBG and HOME funds will be used for affordable housing related projects, public services, economic development, public facilities and infrastructure improvements. Projects must generally benefit low- and moderate-income persons with at least 70% of funding benefitting households with incomes at or below 80% of the area median income.

In accordance with the federal regulations, 24 CFR, Part 91, the City is preparing a draft 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan for its community development programs. This document is a requirement for direct assistance under the HUD funding programs including the CDBG and HOME. The City intends to submit the Annual Action Plan to HUD by August 15th, 2021.

As part of the planning process, the City will be conducting virtual workshop and meetings to solicit public input on programs and activities eligible under the CDBG and HOME funding for eligible areas citywide. Residents are invited to attend and are encouraged to participate in the discussions. Below is the calendar of events:
