The City of North Miami is informing the general public that registration to submit application for Request for Proposals (RFP) from not-for-profit Community-Based Organizations (CBOs) will begin on Wednesday, July 14, 2021.

RFP responses are due by **Wednesday, August 4, 2021 at 5:00 p.m.** and must be submitted online through the following link: <https://portal.neighborlysoftware.com/northmiami/participant> and will be available for access beginning on Wednesday, July 14, 2021.

Public Services activities are funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. Eligible Public Services activities under the CDBG program include, but are not limited to, job placement services, workforce training, childcare, mental health, tutoring, fair housing counseling, energy conservation, financial literacy, summer internship program, etc. CDBG Public Services funding can be used for a range of eligible activities that meet the national objectives including labor, supplies and materials.

A mandatory workshop to provide technical assistance for proposal submission will be conducted on Wednesday, July 21, 2021 from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at Sunkist Grove Community Center, 12500 NW 13th Avenue, North Miami, FL 33167.

The total approved allocation for FY 2021-2022 Public Services funding is **\$118,275**.
