

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-R-87

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE SELECTION OF ELECTRICAL CONTRACTING SERVICES, INC., AS THE LOWEST-RESPONSIVE AND RESPONSIBLE BIDDER TO PROVIDE ALL LABOR, EQUIPMENT, MATERIALS, SERVICES AND EXPERTISE REQUIRED FOR THE INSTALLATION OF SIX (6) EMERGENCY GENERATORS AT THE WINSON WATER TREATMENT PLANT WATER WELLS, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS, CONDITIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS CONTAINED IN INVITATION FOR BID NO. 23-20-21; FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH ELECTRICAL CONTRACTING SERVICES, INC., FOR THE PROVISION OF SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THREE HUNDRED TWENTY-EIGHT THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$328,155.00); PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on April 26, 2021, the City of North Miami (“City”) advertised *Invitation for Bid No. 23-20-21 – Six Emergency Generators for Six Winson Water Treatment Plant Water Wells* (“IFB”), for the purpose of obtaining sealed bids from qualified and experienced contractors to provide the City with the labor, equipment, materials, transportation, and related services necessary to purchase, install and connect six (6) emergency generators with weatherproof enclosures, in accordance with the terms, conditions and specifications contained in the IFB (“Services”); and

WHEREAS, on June 3, 2021, City administration opened and reviewed six (6) timely-submitted sealed bids, ranking each response in the order of cost from the lowest to the highest, as follows: 1) Electrical Contracting Services, Inc.; 2) R & D Electric, Inc.; 3) Zabett Engine Services, Inc.; 4) Soloares Electrical Services; and 5) 360 Electrical & Engineering Services, LLC; and 5) All Florida Contracting Services, LLC; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with City administration’s ranking, the City Manager respectfully requests that the Mayor and City Council approve the selection of Electrical Contracting Services, Inc. (“Contractor”), as the lowest, responsive-responsible bidder in the provision of Services, and authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate and execute

an agreement at a cost not to exceed Three Hundred Twenty-Eight Thousand One Hundred Fifty-Five Dollars (\$328,155.00); and

WHEREAS, Services are expected to be completed within one hundred fifty (150) days from the City's issuance of a Notice to Proceed to Contractor; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined that it is in the City's best interests to approve the selection of Contractor and hereby authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate and execute an agreement for the provision of Services to accomplish the necessary air conditioning unit replacements.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Selection Approval. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby approve the selection of Electrical Contracting Services, Inc., as the lowest, responsive bidder for the installation of air conditioning units, in accordance with the terms, conditions and specifications contained in *Invitation for Bid No. 23-20-21 – Six Emergency Generators for Six Winson Water Treatment Plant Water Wells*.

Section 2. Authority of City Manager and City Attorney. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate and execute an agreement for the provision of Services with Electrical Contracting Services, Inc., at a cost not to exceed Three Hundred Twenty-Eight Thousand One Hundred Fifty-Five Dollars (\$328,155.00).

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
