

**RESOLUTION NO. 2021-R-86**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE SELECTION OF R & D ELECTRIC, INC., AS THE LOWEST-RESPONSIVE AND RESPONSIBLE BIDDER TO PROVIDE ALL LABOR, EQUIPMENT, MATERIALS, SERVICES AND EXPERTISE REQUIRED FOR THE INSTALLATION OF FOUR (4) EMERGENCY GENERATORS AT SANITARY SEWER PUMP STATIONS, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS, CONDITIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS CONTAINED IN INVITATION FOR BID NO. 22-20-21; FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH R & D ELECTRIC, INC., FOR THE PROVISION OF SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY-EIGHT DOLLARS (\$372,468.00); PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND ALL OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, on May 3, 2021, the City of North Miami (“City”) advertised *Invitation for Bid No. 22-20-21 – Four Emergency Generators for the City’s Four Sanitary Sewer Pump Stations* (“IFB”), for the purpose of obtaining sealed bids from qualified and experienced contractors to provide the City with the labor, equipment, materials, transportation, and related services necessary to purchase, install and connect four (4) emergency generators with weatherproof enclosures, in accordance with the terms, conditions and specifications contained in the IFB (“Services”); and

**WHEREAS**, on June 11, 2021, City administration opened and reviewed five (5) timely-submitted sealed bids, ranking each response in the order of cost from the lowest to the highest, as follows: 1) R & D Electric, Inc.; 2) Zabett Engineering Services, Inc.; 3) Cruz Electrical Corp.; 4) Bejar Construction, Inc.; and 5) Soloares Electrical Services; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with City administration’s ranking, the City Manager respectfully requests that the Mayor and City Council approve the selection of R & D Electric, Inc. (“Contractor”), as the lowest, responsive-responsible bidder in the provision of Services, and authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate and execute an agreement at a cost not to exceed Three Hundred Seventy-Two Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Eight Dollars (\$372,468.00); and

**WHEREAS**, Services are expected to be completed within one hundred fifty (150) days from the City's issuance of a Notice to Proceed to Contractor; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council have determined that it is in the City's best interests to approve the selection of Contractor and hereby authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate and execute an agreement for the provision of Services to accomplish the necessary air conditioning unit replacements.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1.** **Selection Approval.** The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby approve the selection of R & D Electric, Inc., as the lowest, responsive bidder for the installation of air conditioning units, in accordance with the terms, conditions and specifications contained in *Invitation for Bid No. 22-20-21 – Four Emergency Generators for the City's Four Sanitary Sewer Pump Stations.*

**Section 2.** **Authority of City Manager and City Attorney.** The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate and execute an agreement for the provision of Services with R & D Electric, Inc., at a cost not to exceed Three Hundred Seventy-Two Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Eight Dollars (\$372,468.00).

**Section 3.** **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
