CDBG PUBLIC SERVICES AWARDS

The City of North Miami (“City”) is an “entitlement” community that receives funding assistance from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”) through the Community Development Block Grant (“CDBG”) and HOME Investment Partnerships Program (“HOME”) programs. On June 22, 2021, the City approved its Annual Action Plan (“Plan”) for FY 2021-2022 for the use of CDBG and HOME funds; the Plan was subsequently submitted to HUD for approval. One of the uses of CDBG funding is the provision of Public Services (including labor, supplies, materials, etc.) through community-based organizations (“CBOs”) to benefit low- and moderate-income persons (at or below 80% of the area median income).

On July 14, 2021, a Request for Proposal (“RFP”) for Public Services was issued to CBOs; proposals were received, reviewed, and awards approved by City Council on September 28, 2021. The following are the CBOs and related awards for FY 2021-2022:
