

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-R-132

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, RATIFYING
THE SUBMITTAL OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY
ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI
AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF
ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION, TO SECURE A FISCAL
YEAR 2021-2022 INNOVATIVE TECHNOLOGY WATER
PROTECTION GRANT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE
DATE, AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council are desirous of applying for and securing a Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Innovative Technology Water Protection Grant from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (“DEP”); and

WHEREAS, the City of North Miami (“City”) is requesting a grant in the amount of Two Hundred Forty-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$245,000.00) with no required match for a total project cost in the amount of Two Hundred Forty-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$245,000.00) ; and

WHEREAS, funds will be used toward the purchase and installation of canal air bubble curtains. which are designed to push back weeds and debris, preventing them from entering the City’s thirty-one (31) canals while allowing boats and wildlife to easily and safely pass through; and

WHEREAS, this project seeks to reduce water pollution within the City’s canal systems by reducing the amount of weeds and debris which serve as pollutants causing nutrients to be released, decreases water quality, and releases hydrogen sulfide, and causes a foul odor; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council wish to ratify the submittal of a grant application as well as to fully authorize the negotiation and execution of an agreement for grant funds between the City and (“DEP”).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Ratification of Submittal of Application. The Mayor and City Council hereby ratify the submittal of the City of North Miami's application for a Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Innovative Technology Water Protection Grant from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection.

Section 2. Authority to City Manager and City Attorney. The City Manager and City Attorney are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute an agreement between the City of North Miami, Florida and the Florida Department of Environmental Protection to obtain grant funds.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
