**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, REAPPOINTING BEATRICE CAZEAU, A MEMBER OF THE FLORIDA BAR, TO SERVE AS SPECIAL MAGISTRATE FOR CODE ENFORCEMENT HEARINGS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO EXECUTE A ONE (1) YEAR LETTER OF AGREEMENT WITH MS. CAZEAU, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 21-51, NORTH MIAMI CODE OF ORDINANCES, AS AMENDED; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND ALL OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, Section 21-51 of the City of North Miami (“City”) Code of Ordinances (“Code”) provides that Special Magistrates shall be appointed by the City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Code requires that Special Magistrates be either retired State of Florida judges, or members in good standing of the Florida Bar for at least five (5) years; and

**WHEREAS**, Beatrice Cazeau, Esq. meets the requirements of the City Code and wishes to continue to serve as a Special Magistrate; and

**WHEREAS**, Beatrice Cazeau has served as a Special Magistrate since 2012; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council desire to designate and reappoint Beatrice Cazeau as a Special Magistrate for Code Enforcement hearings for a one (1) year period.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1. Designation of Special Magistrate.** The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby reappoint Beatrice Cazeau to serve as Special Magistrate for Code Enforcement hearings

**Section 2. Authority of City Manager and City Attorney.** The Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to execute a one (1) year letter of agreement with Ms. Cazeau, in accordance with Section 21-51, North Miami Code of Ordinances as amended.

**Section 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
