N.E. 6th Avenue and N.E. 137th Street Water Main Improvement Project

The City of North Miami is pleased to announce the start of a new Public Works project associated with water main improvements on N.E. 6th Avenue and on N.E. 137th Street.

Scope and Purpose of Work

As part of the City of North Miami's water main improvement program, this project includes upgrading existing infrastructure that is aging or undersized. The work will include approximately 2,100 linear feet of new 12" water main on NE 6th Avenue from NE 131st Street to NE 137th Street and approximately 800 linear feet of new 8" water main on NE 137th Street from NE 6th Avenue to NE 7th Avenue. The project will also include new valves, fire hydrants, service lines, utility testing, and roadway and site restoration. The project intent is to improve system operation and performance as well as improve public health and safety with new water system infrastructure.

Maintenance of Traffic

Work Hours 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM

During lane closures, motorists and pedestrians will be guided through the work zone by warning signs, barricades, and other channelizing devices. Police officers and trained flagging personnel will also be implemented as needed.

Timeline

Project scheduled to begin in April 2022

Project completion is currently scheduled for January 2023

Construction updates will be provided throughout the construction process
