The Meeting will be broadcast live for members of the public on livestream, NoMi TV (Comcast: Channel 77, U-verse: Channel 99), YouTube and Champs.

Interested members of the public are invited to attend the Tentative Charter Board Meeting and may provide oral or written comments on the matter. Any person, not appearing in person, interested in making comments or posing questions on matters of public concern may do so prior to the meeting taking place by email to publiccomment@northmiamifl.gov. Comments must be received by 10 a.m. the day of the Tentative Charter Board Meeting in order to be read into the record during the hearing. Email comments and questions shall not exceed three (3) minutes when read. Comments received after the deadline will become part of the record, but will not be read during the hearing.

- IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 286.0105, FLORIDA STATUTES, ANYONE WISHING TO APPEAL ANY DECISION MADE BY THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI CITY COUNCIL, WITH RESPECT TO ANY MATTER CONSIDERED AT SUCH MEETING OR HEARING, WILL NEED A RECORD OF THE PROCEEDINGS AND, FOR SUCH PURPOSE, MAY NEED TO ENSURE THAT A VERBATIM RECORD OF THE PROCEEDINGS IS MADE, INCLUDING THE TESTIMONY AND EVIDENCE UPON WHICH THE APPEAL IS TO BE BASED.

- IN ACCORDANCE WITH CODE SECTIONS 2-291 AND 2-305, ANY LOBBYISTS MUST REGISTER WITH THE CITY CLERK'S OFFICE BEFORE ADDRESSING THE COUNCIL ON ANY OF THE AGENDA ITEMS.
