

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-R-54

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA,
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT, IN SUBSTANTIALLY THE
ATTACHED FORM, BETWEEN THE CITY OF NORTH
MIAMI AND MIAMI-DADE COUNTY TO IDENTIFY AND
CONTROL POLLUTANT DISCHARGES FROM ANY
SHARED STORM SEWER SYSTEM WITHIN THE CITY,
UNDER THE NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE
ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT NO. FLS000003, AS
REQUIRED BY THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT
OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION, PURSUANT TO
SECTION 403.0885, FLORIDA STATUTES, FOR A
MAXIMUM FINANCIAL COMMITMENT NOT-TO-
EXCEED EIGHTEEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED
TWENTY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$18,624.00) ANNUALLY;
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND ALL
OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, the City of North Miami, Florida (“City”), is a named Co-Permittee under the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection (“FDEP”) Permit No. FLS000003 Authorization to Discharge under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System; and

WHEREAS, the FDEP requires all state and municipal Co-Permittees to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with Miami-Dade County, pursuant to Section 403.0885, Florida Statutes, and the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit Regulations, to identify and control pollutant discharges in shared municipal separate storm sewer systems; and

WHEREAS, City Administration respectfully requests that the Mayor and City Council authorize the City Manager to execute the attached Interlocal Agreement, pursuant to requirements of state laws and regulations; and as in the best interest of the public health, safety, and general welfare.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:**

Section 1. Authority of City Manager. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby, authorize the City Manager to execute an Interlocal Agreement, in substantially the attached form, between the City of North Miami and Miami-Dade County to identify and control pollutant discharges from any shared storm sewer system within the City, under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit No. FLS000003, as required by the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection, pursuant to Section 403.0885, Florida Statutes, for a maximum financial contribution not-to-exceed Eighteen Thousand Six Hundred Twenty-Four Dollars (\$18,624.00) annually.

Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
