

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA,
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY
ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN
AGREEMENT WITH HOMETOWN TROLLEY
INCORPORATED FOR THE PURCHASE OF FOUR (4)
FREIGHTLINER 31' VILLAGER MODEL TROLLEYS;
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND ALL
OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, on June 12, 2022, the City of North Miami ("City") Council adopted resolution authorizing the purchase of four (4) Freightliner 31' Villager (2022 Year) Model Trolleys from Hometown Trolley Incorporated ("Hometown"); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have authorized the issuance of purchase orders to secure the purchase of the trolleys; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the purchase orders, City staff recommends the execution of an agreement for the purchase of the trolleys; and

WHEREAS, City Staff respectfully requests that the City Council to authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Hometown, for the purchase of the four (4) trolleys in an amount not to exceed Nine Hundred One Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-Eight Dollars (\$901,428.00); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council find that entering into an agreement for the purchase of trolleys is in the best interest of the City and wish to authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate and execute an agreement in support of this objective.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Authority of City Manager and City Attorney. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate and execute an agreement with Hometown Trolley Incorporated, at a cost not exceed Nine Hundred One Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-Eight Dollars (\$901,428.00).

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
