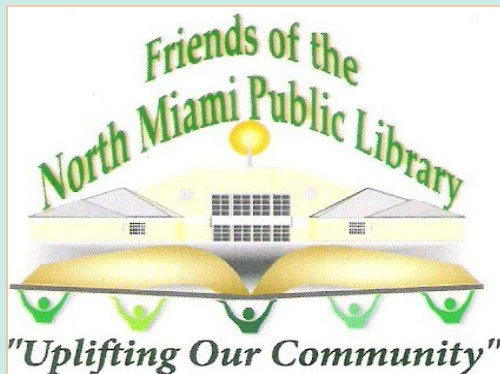

Reciprocal borrowing privileges are available for residents of Hialeah, North Miami Beach and the Miami-Dade Public Library Systems. There is a charge for residents of Bal Harbour, Miami Shores, Surfside and out-of-the-area residents who wish to apply for a library card.

All applicants must be present when the application is completed. Anyone under 18 years of age must have parental authorization to obtain a card.

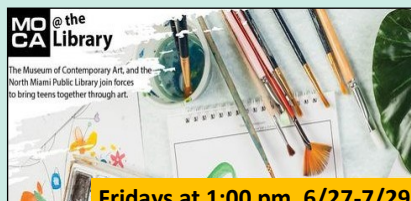

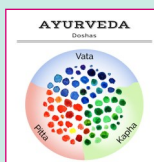

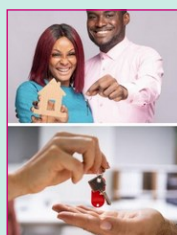
We learned to dance the "Kompa," the modern merengue dance of Haiti, at the NoMi Library! (With instructor Tony La Venture).

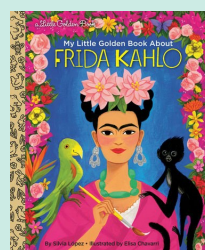

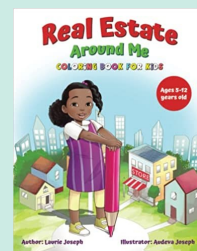

Carl Sagan, astronomer, cosmologist, and science writer, wrote this about books:

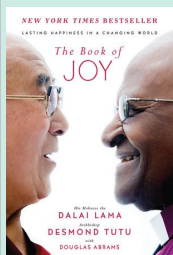
"What an astonishing thing a book is. It's a flat object made from a tree with flexible parts on which are imprinted lots of funny dark squiggles.
