

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-R-109

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER TO THE EXISTING PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI AND AECOM TECHNICAL SERVICES, INC., FOR ADDITIONAL PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE REHABILITATION OF PUMP STATION A, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED SEVENTEEN THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY-EIGHT DOLLARS (\$117,848.00), PURSUANT TO REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS #12-14-15 CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL ARCHITECTURAL & ENGINEERING SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on March 24, 2015, the City of North Miami (“City”) advertised *Request for Qualifications #12-14-15, Continuing Architectural & Engineering Services* (“RFQ”), for the purpose of retaining a pool of experienced, licensed and insured architectural and engineering firms to provide on a continuing as-needed, when needed basis, the following specific services: Architecture/Interior Design, Landscape Architecture, Urban Planning & Design, Environmental Engineering, Transportation/Traffic Engineering, Water Resources/Stormwater Design, Wastewater Engineering, Geotechnical/Material Testing and Mechanical/Electrical/Plumbing (“Services”); and

WHEREAS, the RFQ was undertaken in accordance with Florida’s Consultants’ Competitive Negotiation Act (“CCNA”), under Section 287.055, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, in response to the RFQ, AECOM Technical Services, Inc. (“Consultant”) submitted its qualifications for the provision of Water Resources and Stormwater Design Services and was approved to be included on the City’s list of pre-qualified firms pursuant to Resolution No. 2015-R-52; and

WHEREAS, Pump Station “A”, which is located in the area of Northwest 125th Street and Northwest 11th Avenue, is the City’s first wastewater pump station, is over fifty (50) years old, and is undergoing rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, on October 9, 2018, the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, authorized the City Manager to negotiate and execute an agreement between the City of

North Miami and AECOM Technical Services, Inc, for professional engineering services for the rehabilitation of Pump Station “A” pursuant to Resolution No. 2018-R-128; and

WHEREAS, as part of the rehabilitation of the aging pump station, the Consultant has recently completed design and permitting for the rehabilitation of the station along with engineering including mechanical, electrical, and structural improvements for the Master Pump Station; and

WHEREAS, the additional services needed for the rehabilitation of Pump Station “A” project will include: construction phase services, construction inspections, construction engineering and document control, quality assurance and oversight for a not to exceed amount of One Hundred Seventeen Thousand Eight Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars (\$117,848.00); and

WHEREAS, City administration respectfully requests that the Mayor and City Council authorize the proposed change order to the existing agreement with Consultant for the provision of Services, relating to the Pump Station “A” rehabilitation project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. **Authority of City Manager.** The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the City Manager to issue a change order to the existing agreement between the City of North Miami and AECOM Technical Services, Inc., for additional professional engineering services for the rehabilitation of Pump Station “A”, pursuant to Request for Qualifications #12-14-15 - *Continuing Architectural & Engineering Services*, in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Seventeen Thousand Eight Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars (\$117,848.00).

Section 2. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
