**SUMMARY AND NOTICE FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON
FY2021-2022 ACTION PLAN AMENDMENT**

Annually, the City of North Miami (City) receives an allocation of federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). Notice is hereby given that the City, through its Housing and Social Services (HSS) Department, proposes to make a Substantial Amendment to its HUD FY2021-2022 Annual Action Plan to reallocate CDBG funds from various activities and various fiscal years as outlined below.

Under Consolidated Plan/Annual Action Plan requirements at 24 CFR Part, 91 Subpart B, and the City’s adopted Citizen Participation Plan, the City, through this Substantial Amendment, provides the opportunity for public comment. For this amendment, the city considers an Annual Action Plan amendment as substantial if there will be a change in an activity cost of more than 10% and the discontinuation of an activity described in the plan before activity completion. After receiving public comments, the Amendment will be submitted to the North Miami City Council for approval, and changes made in HUD’s Integrated Disbursement and Information System (IDIS).

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD AND PROCESS:

This Annual Action Plan substantial amendment is available for a 30-day public review and comment period from **October 17, 2022, to November 16, 2022**. Citizens wishing to submit written comments during the public review and comment period may mail them, postmarked no later than **November 16, 2022**, to the following address:
