**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA APPROVING
THE EXECUTION OF A MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT AND
JOINT DECLARATION BETWEEN THE CITY OF NORTH
MIAMI AND THE CITY OF SWEETWATER TO PROVIDE
ADEQUATE LEVELS OF POLICE SERVICES; PROVIDING
FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND ALL OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, the entering of a mutual aid agreement between municipalities is authorized by Chapter 23, Florida Statutes, Florida Mutual Aid Act; and

WHEREAS, the City of North Miami and the City of Sweetwater are desirous of entering into a Mutual Aid Agreement and Joint Declaration with each other to provide adequate levels of police services to address any foreseeable routine or emergency situation to ensure the public safety of their residents; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council wish to approve and authorize the execution of the Mutual Aid Agreement with the City of Sweetwater and the accompanying Joint Declaration will benefit the residents of the City of North Miami and should be entered into with the City of Sweetwater.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. **Approval of Agreement and Joint Declaration.** The City Council hereby approves the Mutual Aid Agreement and Joint Declaration between the City of North Miami and the City of Sweetwater attached as “Exhibit 1.”


Section 2. **Authority of City Manager and Police Chief.** The City Manager and the Chief of Police are authorized to execute the Mutual Aid Agreement and Joint Declaration attached as “Exhibit 1” with the City of Sweetwater.

Section 3. **Effective Date.** This Resolution will be effective upon adoption.
