

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-R-28

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI AND TETRA TECH, INC., FOR ENGINEERING DESIGN, PERMITTING AND CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATION SERVICES FOR THE RAW WATER TRANSMISSION MAINS REPLACEMENT PROJECT, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY-SIX THOUSAND SIXTY DOLLARS (\$276,060.00), PURSUANT TO REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS #08-17-18 CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL ARCHITECTURAL & ENGINEERING SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on December 7, 2017, the City of North Miami (“City”) advertised *Request for Qualifications #08-17-18, Continuing Professional Architectural & Engineering Services* (“RFQ”), for the purpose of retaining a pool of experienced, licensed and insured architectural and engineering firms to provide on a continuing as-needed, when needed basis, the following specific services: Architecture, Landscape Architecture, Civil Engineering, Planning and Urban Design, Roadway, Traffic and Transportation Engineering and Consulting, Water/Waste Water Engineering, Water Resources and Stormwater Design and Environmental Engineering (“Services”); and

WHEREAS, the RFQ was undertaken in accordance with Florida’s Consultants’ Competitive Negotiation Act, under Section 287.055, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, in response to the RFQ, Tetra Tech, Inc. (“Consultant”) submitted its qualifications for the provision of Water Resources and Stormwater Design Services and was approved to be included on the City’s list of pre-qualified firms pursuant to Resolution No. 2019-R-15; and

WHEREAS, as a part of the City administration’s commitment to improve service and reliability to the City’s customers, the Public Works Department is moving forward to strategically replace and rehabilitate water and sewer pipes throughout the service areas; and

WHEREAS, City staff has secured a proposal from the Consultant to provide engineering services for the proposed replacement of raw water transmission mains located between the

following wells described below and connecting to the City's Winson Water Treatment Plant: Well Nos. 1 and 2 - Water Treatment Plant at the NW 121st Street and NW 11th Avenue intersection, Well Nos. 3 and 4 - Oleander Park at the NW 121st Street and NW 13th Avenue intersection, Well Nos. 5 and 6 - Kiwanis Park at the NW 121st Street and NW 16th Avenue intersection, Well Nos. 7 and 8 - Sunkist Grove Community Center site at NW 125th Street and NW 13th Avenue intersection; and

WHEREAS, City staff has secured a proposal from the Consultant to provide engineering design and construction administration services including, but not limited to: surveys and geotechnical investigations, utilities verification and subsurface evaluation, hydraulic model evaluation, engineering design and permitting, bidding and award services, and construction administration throughout project completion; and

WHEREAS, Consultant has agreed to provide service services for a total fee not to exceed Two Hundred Seventy-Six Thousand Sixty Dollars (\$276,060.00); and


WHEREAS, the City administration respectfully requests that the Mayor and City Council authorize the Interim City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate and execute an agreement with Consultant for the provision of Services, relating to the raw water transmission mains replacement project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Authority of Interim City Manager and City Attorney. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the Interim City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate and execute an agreement between the City of North Miami and Tetra Tech, Inc., for the raw water transmission mains replacement project, at a cost not to exceed Two Hundred Seventy-Six Thousand Sixty Dollars (\$276,060.00).

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
