

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-R-46

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE POLICE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT, IN SUBSTANTIALLY THE ATTACHED FORM, BETWEEN THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI AND SOUTH FLORIDA POLICE BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION (PBA) FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2021, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2024; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Chapter 447, Florida Statutes, has established a formal collective bargaining procedure for public employees in the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, the South Florida Police Benevolent Association (“PBA”) has been certified by the Public Employees Relations Commission of the State of Florida as bargaining agent for Police Officers and Police Sergeants of the City of North Miami (“City”); and


WHEREAS, the members of the North Miami Police Bargaining Unit have voted to approve the Police Collective Bargaining Agreement with the City of North Miami, attached hereto as “Exhibit 1”.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:


Section 1. Authorization to execute Agreement. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby, authorize the execution of the Police Collective Bargaining Agreement, in substantially the attached form, between the City of North Miami and South Florida Police Benevolent Association (PBA) for a period of three (3) years commencing October 1, 2021, through September 30, 2024.

Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
