

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-R-155

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI AND KIMLEY-HORN AND ASSOCIATES, INC., FOR ENGINEERING CONSULTING SERVICES FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A CITYWIDE TRAFFIC CALMING STUDY, AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED NINETY-NINE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$299,535.00); PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on December 7, 2017, the City advertised *Request for Qualifications #08-17-18, Continuing Professional Architectural & Engineering Services* (“RFQ”), for the purpose of retaining a pool of experienced, licensed and insured architectural and engineering firms to provide on a continuing as-needed, when needed basis, the following specific services: Architecture, Landscape Architecture, Civil Engineering, Planning and Urban Design, Roadway, Traffic and Transportation Engineering and Consulting, Water/Waste Water Engineering, Water Resources and Stormwater Design and Environmental Engineering (“Services”); and

WHEREAS, the RFQ was undertaken in accordance with Florida’s Consultants’ Competitive Negotiation Act, under Section 287.055, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, in response to the RFQ, Kimley Horn & Associates, Inc. (“Consultant”) submitted its qualifications for the provision of professional engineering services and was approved to be included on the City’s list of pre-qualified firms pursuant to Resolution No. 2019-R-15; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project encompasses the development of traffic calming study to assess traffic patterns, the magnitude of speeding traffic and potential traffic calming improvements along local residential streets within the City’s boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the services will include: initial citywide meeting and GIS mapping database, traffic data collection and analysis, conceptual traffic calming plan, planning level opinion of probable cost, city meetings, documentation of findings, coordination with local government

agencies, for total fee not to exceed Two Hundred Ninety-Nine Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-Five Dollars (\$299,535.00); and

WHEREAS, the City administration respectfully requests that the Mayor and City Council authorize the City manager and City Attorney to negotiate and execute an agreement with Consultant for the provision of Services, relating to the proposed traffic calming study project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:


Section 1. **Authority of City Manager and City Attorney.** The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate and execute an agreement between the City of North Miami and Kimley Horn & Associates, Inc., for the development of a Citywide Traffic Calming Study, at a cost not to exceed Two Hundred Ninety-Nine Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-Five Dollars (\$299,535.00).

Section 2. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
