

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-R-166

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, RATIFYING
THE SUBMITTAL OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY
ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI
AND UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE TO
SECURE A GRANT FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT
MENTAL HEALTH AND WELLNESS ACT PROGRAM;
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND ALL
OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, the City of North Miami (the “City”) submitted an application for a grant from the United States Department of Justice’s (“USDOJ”) Law Enforcement Mental Health and Wellness Act (“LEMHWA”) Program; and

WHEREAS, the City requested a grant in the amount of One Hundred Forty-Seven Thousand Three Hundred Ninety-Four Dollars and Zero Cents (\$147,394.00), with no required match from the City; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds will be utilized to improve the delivery of and access to mental health and wellness services for the North Miami Police Department (“NMPD”) through the implementation of peer support, training, family resources, suicide prevention, and other promising practices for wellness programs; and

WHEREAS, the program will fund projects that develop knowledge, increase awareness of effective mental health and wellness strategies, increase the skills and abilities of NMPD’s law enforcement officers, and other promising practices for wellness programs; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council find it in the best interest of the City and its residents to ratify the submittal of the grant application as well as to fully authorize the negotiation and execution of an agreement between the City and the USDOJ for the purpose of securing grant funds.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:**

Section 1. Ratification of Submittal of Grant Application. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby ratify the submittal of the City of North Miami's application for a grant from the United States Department of Justice's Law Enforcement Mental Health and Wellness Act Program.

Section 2. Authority of City Manager and City Attorney. The City Manager and City Attorney are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute an agreement between the City of North Miami and the United States Department of Justice.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
