

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-R-47

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO ISSUE PURCHASE ORDERS FOR THE PURCHASE OF THE FOLLOWING VEHICLES: THIRTEEN (13) PICK-UP TRUCKS, EIGHT (8) SPORT UTILITY VEHICLES, TWO (2) DUMP TRUCKS, ONE (1) FORESTRY TRUCK, TWO (2) VANS, ONE (1) BACKHOE LOADER, ONE (1) TRAILER, ONE (1) TRENCHER, ONE (1) COMPACT EXCAVATOR AND ONE (1) GOLF CART, AT AN APPROXIMATE-AGGREGATE COST NOT TO EXCEED ONE MILLION THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,300,000) FROM VARIOUS COMPETITIVELY SELECTED VENDORS, UTILIZING THE COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROVISION PURSUANT TO SEC. 7-169 OF THE CITY CODE, ON CONTRACTS AWARDED THROUGH THE FLORIDA SHERIFFS ASSOCIATION, UNDER CONTRACT NUMBERS FSA23-VEH21.0, FSA23-VEL31.0 AND FSA23-EQU21.0, UNDER SOURCEWELL CONTRACT NUMBER 2024 091521-NAF AND UNDER STATE OF FLORIDA CONTRACT NUMBER 25100000-23-STC; AND DECLARING TWENTY-FIVE (25) VEHICLES AS SURPLUS PROPERTY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 7-145 OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Florida Sheriffs Association (“FSA”), Sourcewell, and the State of Florida offer purchasing contracts for a variety of vehicles, equipment, and services that are available to eligible agencies such as the City of North Miami; and

WHEREAS, contracts awarded through these programs are competitively bid and offer favorable pricing and terms for eligible agencies to take advantage of; and

WHEREAS, the contracts are designed to provide participating agencies and local municipal governments, with a mechanism for increasing their purchasing power by offering the most economically priced cars, trucks, vans, and equipment, tailored to the agency’s specific requirements; and

WHEREAS, utilization of the FSA, Sourcewell, and State of Florida contracts guarantees participating agencies and local municipal governments, the availability of competitive pricing

under the Award by selected vendors (“Vendors”), as long as vehicles and equipment are available to order through the manufacturer; and

WHEREAS, City desires to purchase certain equipment utilizing the following contracts awarded through FSA, Sourcewell and the State of Florida: *FSA23-VEH21.0 – Heavy Trucks & Buses, FSA23-VEL31.0 - Pursuit, Administrative, and Other Vehicles, FSA23-EQUI21.0 – Heavy Equipment, Sourcewell Contract No. 2024 091521-NAF and State of Florida Contract No. 25100000-23-STC*; and

WHEREAS, the City administration has identified the need for the following vehicles: Thirteen (13) Pick-Up Trucks, Eight (8) Sport Utility Vehicles, Two (2) Dump Trucks, One (1) Forestry Truck, Two (2) Vans, One (1) Backhoe Loader, One (1) Trailer, One (1) Trencher, One (1) Excavator and One (1) Golf Cart (collectively referred to herein as “Vehicles”); and

WHEREAS, the Vehicles will be purchased at an approximate-aggregate cost not to exceed One Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,300,000.00), from competitively selected Vendors; and

WHEREAS, Section 7-169 of the City Code authorizes the City to participate in cooperative purchasing agreements for the procurement of supplies or services with one (1) or more public entities; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has determined that it is in the City’s best interest to expeditiously purchase the equipment for immediate public service use while utilizing the most cost-effective means currently available to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Declaration of Surplus. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami hereby declare the twenty-five (25) vehicles specified on the attached Exhibit “1” as surplus property.

Section 2. Authority of City Manager. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the City Manager to dispose of the surplus property and to issue Purchase Orders for the purchase of the following vehicles: Thirteen (13) Pick-Up Trucks, Eight (8) Sport Utility Vehicles, Two (2) Dump Trucks, One (1) Forestry Truck, Two (2) Vans, One (1) Backhoe Loader, One (1) Trailer, One (1) Trencher, One (1) Excavator and One (1) Golf

Cart, at an approximate-aggregate cost not-to-exceed One Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,300,000.00) from various competitively selected vendors, utilizing the cooperative purchasing provision pursuant to Sec. 7-169 of the City Code, on contracts awarded through the Florida Sheriffs Association and the State of Florida, under Contract numbers: *FSA23-VEH21.0 – Heavy Trucks & Buses, FSA23-VEL31.0 - Pursuit, Administrative, and Other Vehicles, FSA23-EQUI21.0 – Heavy Equipment, Sourcewell Contract No. 2024 091521-NAF and State of Florida Contract No. 25100000-23-STC*; and

Section 3. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
