

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-R-147

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI AND BLACK & VEATCH CORPORATION, FOR ADDITIONAL SERVICES NECESSARY FOR THE COMPLETION OF A WATER REVENUE IMPACT STUDY, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FORTY-EIGHT THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED THIRTY DOLLARS (\$48,930.00), PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on December 7, 2017, the City of North Miami (“City”) advertised *Request for Qualifications #08-17-18, Continuing Architectural & Engineering Services* (“RFQ”), for the purpose of retaining a pool of experienced, licensed and insured architectural and engineering firms to provide on a continuing as-needed, when needed basis, the following specific services: Architecture/Interior Design, Landscape Architecture, Urban Planning & Design, Environmental Engineering, Transportation/Traffic Engineering, Water Resources/Stormwater Design, Wastewater Engineering, Geotechnical/Material Testing and Mechanical/Electrical/Plumbing (“Services”); and

WHEREAS, the RFQ was undertaken in accordance with Florida’s Consultants’ Competitive Negotiation Act (“CCNA”), under Section 287.055, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, in response to the RFQ, AECOM Technical Services, Inc. (“Consultant”) submitted its qualifications for the provision of Water Resources and Stormwater Design Services and was approved to be included on the City’s list of pre-qualified firms pursuant to Resolution No. 2019-R-15; and

WHEREAS, on April 9, 2024, the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, adopted Resolution No. 2024-R-54 authorizing the City Manager to negotiate and execute an agreement between the City of North Miami and Black & Veatch Corporation, in an amount not exceeding One Hundred Seventeen Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$117,200.00) for the development of an Infrastructure Assessment and Capital Projects Delivery Analysis study; and

WHEREAS, in order to better evaluate various scenarios of capital improvement costs and projected operation and maintenance costs needed to enhance the City’s current potable water

resilience, staff has asked Black & Veatch to prepare a water revenue impact study based on a thirty (30) year revenue impact analysis; and

WHEREAS, the additional services needed to complete the water revenue impact study include: project initiation and data collection, projection of revenue under existing rates, projection of capital improvement scenarios debt financing, projection of operating and management costs, development of thirty (30) year water revenue impact, and completion of a revenue impact analysis council presentation and technical memorandum, for a cost not to exceed the amount of Forty-Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$48,930.00); and


WHEREAS, City administration respectfully requests that the Mayor and City Council authorize the proposed change order to the existing agreement with Consultant for the provision of additional services, relating to the Water Revenue Impact Study.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:


Section 1. **Authority of Interim City Manager.** The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the Interim City Manager to issue an amendment to the existing agreement between the City of North Miami and Black & Veatch Corporation, for additional services for the completion of a Water Revenue Impact Study, in an amount not to exceed Forty-Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$48,930.00).

Section 2. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
