

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-R-32

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER TO ISSUE PURCHASE ORDERS FOR THE PURCHASE OF THE FOLLOWING VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT: TWO (2) COMBINATION JETTING VACUUM TRUCKS AND TWO (2) PASSENGER BUSES, AT AN AGGREGATE COST NOT TO EXCEED ONE MILLION THREE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,350,000) FROM VARIOUS COMPETITIVELY SELECTED VENDORS, UTILIZING THE COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROVISION PURSUANT TO SEC. 7-169 OF THE CITY CODE, ON CONTRACTS AWARDED THROUGH THE FLORIDA SHERIFFS ASSOCIATION, UNDER CONTRACT NUMBERS FSA23-VEH21.1 AND FSA23-EQU21.0, THROUGH THE NATIONAL PURCHASING COOPERATIVE SOURCEWELL, UNDER CONTRACT NUMBERS 101221-SCA AND 063020-BBB AND THROUGH THE STATE OF FLORIDA, UNDER CONTRACT NUMBER 25100000-23-STC; AND DECLARING CERTAIN VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT AS SURPLUS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, City staff has identified several City vehicles and pieces of equipment which have exceeded their useful life term, and which require extensive mechanical work to remain part of the City's fleet; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with section 7-145 of the North Miami Code of Ordinances, the Purchasing Director recommends that these vehicles be declared as surplus and disposed of in a manner most advantageous to the City; and

WHEREAS, the following vehicles and equipment will be purchased to replace the surplus items and to supplement the City's current fleet: Two (2) combination jetting vacuum trucks and Two (2) passenger buses; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Sheriffs Association ("FSA"), Sourcewell, and the State of Florida Department of Management Services offer purchasing contracts for a variety of vehicles, equipment, and services that are available for use by eligible agencies, such as the City of North Miami; and

WHEREAS, contracts awarded through these cooperative purchasing programs are competitively bid and offer favorable pricing and terms for member agencies to take advantage of; and

WHEREAS, Section 7-169 of the City Code authorizes the City to participate in cooperative purchasing agreements for the procurement of supplies or services with one (1) or more public entities; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 7-169 of the City Code, the City administration respectfully requests that the Mayor and City Council authorize the Interim City Manager to issue purchase orders to Vendors for the provision of vehicles and equipment in an amount not to exceed One Million Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$1,350,000), based on cooperative purchasing contracts issued by the Florida Sheriffs Association (“FSA”), Sourcewell, and the State of Florida, respectively.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council find the purchase of the vehicles at a substantial savings, in accordance with the cooperative purchasing contracts, is in the best interest of the City.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. **Declaration of Surplus.** The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida hereby declare the following vehicles and equipment as surplus in accordance with Section 7-145 of the Code of Ordinances: Two (2) 1999 Thomas Passenger Buses (Parks & Recreation); One (1) 2005 Sterling Combination Truck (Stormwater) and One (1) 2014 Freightliner Combination Truck (Water & Sewer).

Section 2. **Authority of Interim City Manager.** The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the Interim City Manager to issue purchase orders to various vendors, at an aggregate cost not to exceed One Million Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$1,350,000), utilizing the cooperative purchasing provision pursuant to Sec. 7-169 of the City Code, for the purchase of two (2) combination jetting vacuum trucks, and two (2) passenger buses, based on cooperative purchasing contracts issued through the Florida Sheriffs Association (“FSA”), Sourcewell, and the State of Florida.

Section 2. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
